Programs at Sunnybrae

Early Literacy/English Language Development

- Served students entering grades 1-3
- 210 students attended

Extended School Year (Special Education)

- 47 students attended

Kick-Off to Kindergarten Classes

- 40 students attended

Early Literacy Program

Balanced Literacy Curriculum

- Curriculum planned with a Reading Intervention Teacher and Principal on Special Assignment
- Professional Development for the teachers
- Coaching with classroom support and demonstration lessons

Curriculum focused on Reading Recovery and Early Literacy teaching strategies

Pre & Post Running Record Assessment

- 71% made gains, 29% maintained their levels

Programs at Borel

SM-FC Math with English Language Development support

- Served students entering grades 4-6
- 198 students attended

Elevate Math

- Silicon Valley Education Foundation program for students entering grades 7 & 8
- 55 students attended

Extended School Year (Special Education)

- 19 students attended

Math Programs

SM-FC Created Curriculum

- Planned by the summer school teachers with support from San Mateo County Office math consultant
- Professional Development for the teachers provided by San Mateo County Office math consultant
- Curriculum focused on California Math Standards and teaching strategies
- Pre & Post Assessment from Galileo for grades 4 - 6
 - 56% made gains, 26% maintained their levels

Elevate Math curriculum for 7th & 8th graders and PD for teachers

Enrichment at Borel & Bayside Theater

Fee Based Programs

Classes for the Arts:

Music- Instrumental and Choral (entering grades 6 & 7)

22 students attended Music

Theater/Drama (entering grades 4-8)

32 students attended Theater/Drama

Tuition scholarships provided for 12 students from Title I schools

Estimated Costs to SMFC

- Lead Teachers & Site Office Assistants \$25,000
- SMFC Math and Early Literacy Programs \$85,000
- Elevate Math \$30,000
- Kick-Off to Kindergarten \$10,000
- Extended School Year \$80,000
- Enrichment \$11,400
