Opportunity Gaps in Marin County



Flexible Time to Support and Engage Each Student

English, Social Science, Math, and Science teachers work as a team to educate their students for two years. They will develop interdisciplinary projects to engage students in meaningful work while they ensure that all students master essential knowledge and skills.

Teachers will use co-teaching, which will allow more flexibility and variability in the time that each student meets with each teacher. If students are already proficient in learning goals, teachers will help them move further and deeper in their learning. When students need support, our teachers will provide them the time and resources they need to accelerate their learning.


Our teachers will masterfully differentiate instruction for students based upon their needs and interests. Through project based learning, use of technology, and flexible use of time we will engage and support each learner.
