Re: Bid Protest - Bahia Vista Elementary School Shade Structure

Massa Construction Co., Inc. requests that the proposal submitted on June 8, 2017, by JCP Industries for the Bahia Vista Elementary School Shade Structure, Project No. RFQP PM-04-17 be declared non-responsive to the bid requirements and that JCP Industries be disqualified as the apparent low bidder.

JCP Industries failed to list a subcontractor for the pier drilling scope of work for the installation of eight concrete piers required to support the shade structure columns. This action by JCP is in violation of the Project Manual requirements and the California Public Contract Code Section 4100 which prevents bid shopping of subcontractors by a prime contractor.

Based on the information presented in this protest, Massa Construction Co., Inc. should be designated as the actual low bidder and awarded the contract for the Bahia Vista School Shade Structure.

Project Requirements allow the District to Disqualify the JCP Industries Proposal

The following conditions and requirements as stated in the Project Manual provide the basis for the rejection of the JCP Industries bid proposal by the San Rafael City Schools District:

Section 00 21 13: Instructions To Bidders:

2nd Para: "San Rafael City Schools ("District") will evaluate information submitted by the apparent low Bidder and, if incomplete or unsatisfactory to District, Bidder's bid may be rejected at the sole discretion of District."

Item 27. "District reserves the right to reject any or all bids, including without limitation the right to reject any or all nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced, or conditional bids, to re-bid, and to reject the bid of any bidder if District believes that it would not be in the best interest of the District to make an award to that bidder, whether because the bid is not responsive or the bidder is unqualified or of doubtful financial ability or fails to meet any other pertinent standard or criteria established by District."

Failure to List a Designated Subcontractor

The proposal by JCP Industries omitted the listing of a drilling subcontractor which creates the possibility for JCP Industries to bid shop the drilling operations after the bid submittal deadline. This potentially unlawful action would provide JCP Industries with a cost advantage over Massa Construction Co., Inc.

Document 00 43 36, Designated Subcontractors List (Public Contract Code 4100-4114):

"Bidder acknowledges and agrees that it must clearly set forth below the name, location and California contractor license number of each subcontractor who will perform work or labor or render service to the Bidder in or about the construction of the Work...in an amount in excess of one-half of one percent (0.5%) of Bidder's total Base Bid and the kind of Work that each will perform."

Qualifications & Experience Required by Drilling Subcontractor

Unless JCP Industries possesses the experience and the drill rig and the steel casing or slurry casing equipment required to professionally install the concrete piers, JCP Industries does not appear to be qualified or adequately experienced to self-perform the complicated installation of the drilled piers.

Protest Letter-Bahia Vista Shade Structure
June 13, 2017
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Document 00 43 36, Designated Subcontractors List (Public Contact Code 4100-4114):

"Bidder acknowledges and agrees that, if Bidder fails to list as to any portion of Work... Bidder must perform that portion itself or be subjected to penalty under applicable law."

The geotechnical report by Miller Pacific Engineering Group, dated April 18, 2017: Foundation & Seismic Design Criteria Update, states the complexity of the drilled pier installation into Bay Mud:

"Due to the presence of loose sandy fill and soft Bay Mud underlying the site and the risk of pier holes caving and/or squeezing is high, the upper pier holes should be cased."

As indicated by the soils conditions in Miller Pacific report, this drilling procedure is a complex operation which should only be undertaken by established drilling experts who possess the experience and the skills along with the drill rigs and the steel casing or drilling stabilization slurry equipment to install the drilled piers into bay mud conditions to prevent the unstable pier holes from collapse or uplift.

Therefore, the proposal by JCP Industries should be rejected based on the failure by JCP Industries to hold the acceptable qualifications and experience required for drilling the piers and for installing the steel or slurry casing with their own crew and equipment.

Potential Violation of the California Public Contract Code

The bid proposal by JCP Industries may be in violation of the California Public Contract Code if JCP Industries attempts to "bid shop" a drilling subcontractor to circumvent the project subcontractor listing requirements or by arranging with a drilling contractor to lease their drilling equipment along with placing their drill operator and casing or slurry crew on the JCP Industries payroll.

A bid proposal which is in violation of the California Public Contract Code is unlawful and should be rejected by the San Rafael City School district as non-responsive.

California Public Contract Code Sections 4100-4114 states:

4101. The Legislature finds that the practices of bid shopping and bid peddling in connection with the construction, alteration, and repair of public improvements often result in poor quality of material and workmanship to the detriment of the public, deprive the public of the full benefits of fair competition among prime contractors and subcontractors, and lead to insolvencies, loss of wages to employees, and other evils.

4106. If a prime contractor fails to specify a subcontractor ... the prime contractor agrees that he or she is fully qualified to perform that portion himself or herself, and that the prime contractor shall perform that portion himself or herself. If after award of contract, the prime contractor subcontracts, except as provided for in Sections 4107 or 4109, any such portion of the work, the prime contractor shall be subject to the penalties named in Section 4111.

Therefore, based on the presented information in this bid protest letter, Massa Construction co., Inc. should be awarded the contract for the construction of the Bahia Vista School Shade Structure.
