


# Extended Learning Opportunities Summer 2017

# Investigations Summer Camp SRCs/Migrant Education


## Abraham Lincoln Elementary

# Project Maker Camp

Comstock Middle School

Served 75 total students, grades 4-8

- ▶ 75% of the families attended.

## Making Opportunities Via Education

- ▶ In partnership with Santa Rosa Metro Chamber and 22 local businesses.
- ▶ 130 students experienced project-based learning in a variety of Santa Rosa businesses.
- ▶ 91 Santa Rosa City Schools students participated, 78 students received 5 elective credits.



# Mariachi Camp

Santa Rosa City Schools and Luther Burbank Center for the Arts hosted the Mariachi Camp

- 72 students from the City of Santa Rosa participated
- 39 SRCS students, representing 19 schools attended the camp
- 6 high school students received 5 credits for completing the program



# Visual Art Camp

Santa Rosa City Schools and Luther Burbank Center for the Arts hosted the Visual Art Camp

- 54 students from the City of Santa Rosa participated
- 19 Santa Rosa City Schools students, representing 10 schools attended the camp
- 1 high school student received 5 credits for completing the program



# Extended School Year

- Extended School Year (ESY) serves students with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs).
- 275 students, Kindergarten through Transitional (age 22)
- 6 Special Day Class, Learning Handicapped students attend Piner High for Credit Recovery and earned 70 credits.



# High School Summer Program



- Traditional Teacher Led Courses
  - 401 students completed courses with a 90% pass rate



- Cyber High
  - 180 students completed 1215 credits
  - **23 students graduated ( 7% increase)**
  - 157 students completed between 5 and 20 credits, helping them to get on course to graduate


