
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

# 2016-17 Results



- 9 Sessions offered
- 16 schools participated (8 Elem, 5 MS & 3 HS)
- 75 teachers participated (41 Elem, 13 MS & 21 HS)
- 1,888 students recovered (1,131 Elem, 280 MS & 477 HS)
- 2,267 students participated (1,321 Elem, 319 MS & 280 HS)



# Project SAIL 2017-18 Expectations

- Reduce chronic absenteeism totals
- Assist all schools with the Truancy process and better serve our families with their needs through our support staff and our recently hired nurse, Elizabeth Munns
- Grow the Elevate Academy program to 21 sessions and motivate students with numerous absences to participate in these wonderful learning opportunities
