- Served students entering grades 1-3
- 146 students attended

Extended School Year (Special Education)

- 49 students attended

- 21 students attended

- 71% made gains, 29% maintained their levels

Programs at Abbott

English Language Development support

- Served students entering grades 4-8
- 157 students completed the program

Extended School Year (Special Education)

- 24 Students attended

Music Enrichment Program

- 10 Students attended

Abbott's Assessment Data

Overall: 73% of students who completed the Literacy Program at Abbott increased their reading fluency.

Enrichment at Bayside Theater

- Fee Based Programs for the Arts
- Theater- Musical Performance of Once On This Island Jr. (entering grades 3-8)- 27 students

Estimated Costs for Summer Programs

- Lead Teachers & Site Office Assistants \$25,000
- SMFC Literacy and English Language Development Programs \$73,000
- Kick-Off to Kindergarten \$10,000
- Extended School Year \$80,000
- Enrichment \$400 (net cost after fee for service)
- Estimated Total Cost \$188,400
