

***ADDENDUM TO
ATHLETIC TRAINING
CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT***

This Addendum is made to the Athletic Training Contractor Agreement effective as of August 18, 2016, between the Santa Clara Unified School District on behalf of Wilcox High School and Santa Clara High School (collectively, the "Recipient"), and Los Gatos Orthopedic Sports Therapy, Inc. (the "Contractor"), of 16615 Lark Ave., Los Gatos, California 95032.

Recipient and Contractor agree to replace Paragraph 2 in the Athletic Training Contractor Agreement with the following:

2. PAYMENT FOR SERVICES. The Recipient will not pay compensation to the Contractor for the Services until the second year of services provided. Payments will be made as follows:

ATC Grant funding from the San Francisco 49ers and the NFL Foundation and Los Gatos Orthopedic Sports Therapy. The grant is to allow schools access to Athletic Training services with the goal of developing increased awareness and utilization of the skill set of the athletic trainer.

In the second year of the ATC Grant (2017-2018) the allocation will be reduced to \$10,500.00 per school with the balance to be funded by the school and/or district. Once Contractor has distributed \$10,500.00, Contractor will invoice the Recipient for the additional \$10,500.00 to cover the balance.

No other fees and/or expenses will be paid to the Contractor, unless such fees and/or expenses have been approved in advance by the appropriate executive on behalf of the Recipient in writing. The Contractor shall be solely responsible for any and all taxes, Social Security contributions or payments, disability insurance, unemployment taxes, and other payroll type taxes applicable to such compensation to the ATC. The Contractor has the right of control over the method of payment for services.

This Addendum is effective as of the last date signed below.
