PURPOSE OF STUDY

- Determine if a bond measure is feasible
- Identify how to create a measure consistent with community priorities
- Gather information needed for communications & outreach




METHODOLOGY OF STUDY

- Conducted August 15th to August 23rd, 2017
- 698 District voters likely to participate in November 2018 election, with June 2018 subset
- Mixed-Method approach
 - Recruited via phone and email
 - Data collection via phone and online
 - 17-minute average interview length
- Overall margin of error is $\pm 3.42\%$

INITIAL BALLOT TEST


In order to:

- Upgrade classrooms, science labs, libraries, career training facilities, and instructional technology to support student achievement in math, science, engineering, technology, and the arts
- Acquire, renovate, construct and equip classrooms, sites and facilities to relieve overcrowding
- And improve older schools so they meet the same safety and academic standards as newer schools

Shall the Santa Clara Unified School District issue <425/875> million dollars in bonds at legal interest rates, with independent citizen oversight, no money for administrator salaries, and all money staying local?








TAX THRESHOLD




SUPPORT FOR MEASURE AT \$285 & \$139 PER YEAR FOR TYPICAL OWNER








POSITIVE ARGUMENTS






INTERIM BALLOT TEST






NEGATIVE ARGUMENTS

KEY CONCLUSIONS

○ Is it feasible to move forward with a bond measure?

Yes.

- Voters perceive that improving the quality of education is the most important issues facing the community
- Strong natural support for bond (70%)
- Popular projects
- Strong positive arguments
- All ballot tests above 55% threshold



CONSIDERATIONS & TAKE-AWAYS

- Poll is a **snapshot** in time, not a crystal ball
- **Election Timing:** Both June '18 & November'18 are feasible
- **Price Tag:** Tax Rate Range \$49 to \$54 per \$100K AV
- **Priorities:** Facility repairs, STEM classrooms and labs, career tech, and equity across schools
- **Education & Outreach:** Voter outreach & education are critical so voters understand the need, the plan, accountabilities, and the benefits.
