Attached please find a Request for Approval of School Sponsored Activity form and supporting documents for the 2016 LCHS trip to Yosemite National Park. Tom Traeger and I are pleased that the updated procedures and policies as well as application and selection process for the trip resulted in a very positive experience last year. We expect that our efforts to make sure that all students are safe and supported and that the program retains its academic emphasis will yield another amazing experience in February, 2016.

To review, the changes to the program last year included:

1. A more detailed and intensive application, requiring a reflective student essay, a teacher recommendation, and clarified information regarding payment and partial refunds for withdrawal.
2. The addition of a participation contract with minimum academic, attendance, disciplinary, and behavioral expectations.
3. Request for parental permission to search students' bags before boarding the bus to Yosemite.
4. Adjustments to the budget that allow for two parent chaperones to attend in addition to the five teacher chaperones, reducing our ratio of adults to students.
5. More detailed information on the academic benefits of the NatureBridge curriculum.

We are excited every year to take La Cañada High School students to one of our nation's premier National Parks for a unique cross-curricular learning experience, and we take great pride in the fact that this trip has become part of a meaningful 40+ year local tradition. We appreciate you submitting this trip to the Governing Board for approval and look forward to sharing stories of our experience with you all when we return from the trip next spring.

Rationale for activity:

- A) Explain the educational value and relate to the instructional program or sponsoring organization and Policy 1100.

Students learn about the natural sciences, leadership skills, group dynamics, history, and culture of the Yosemite National Park area. NatureBridge field science and writing curriculum is developed in alignment with Common Core and Next Generation Science Standards for public instruction and supports schoolwide learning goals at La Canada High School.

- B) Explain impact on instructional time and justification for any time lost.

This trip will impact three days of instruction this year due to the fact that Monday, 2/15/16, is the Presidents Day Holiday and Tuesday, 2/16/16, is a Buy-Back day. Students participating in this trip must receive advance approval for missed instructional time from each teacher and are encouraged to bring work with them to Yosemite. The students must make up any work missed while they are gone and will be given opportunities during off-trail time to work on assignments independently and with chaperone assistance. Teacher chaperones leave meaningful lesson plans for their substitute teachers for the instructional time that is missed.


How is financial assistance provided to students in need:
