Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: This modernization project consists of the construction of five (5) new kindergarten classrooms, including a transitional kindergarten, one preschool classroom, a new administration building with student support spaces to replace inadequate space and bring the school up to current educational and structural standards. Spaces to be modernized include six classrooms, a music room, extended learning spaces, a "newcomers" classroom, and remodeling of office space into one new primary classroom. An outdoor learning courtyard and parking lot and drop-off/pick-up areas are included in the re-design.
