

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE SANTA ROSA CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT DECLARING PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE DISTRICT SURPLUS AND OF LIMITED VALUE PURSUANT TO EDUCATION CODE SECTION 17546

WHEREAS, Education Code section 17546 authorizes the Board of Education district to dispose of surplus personal property by private sale if, by unanimous vote of those members present, the Board finds that the property, whether one or more items, does not exceed in value the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500), and

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 17546 further authorizes the Board, after having made the finding above, to authorize the property to be sold by private sale by an employee of the District.

WHEREAS, Education Code section 17546 also authorizes the Board to determine, by unanimous vote of those members present that the property is of insufficient value to defray the costs of arranging a sale; and

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 17546 further authorizes the Board, after having made the finding above, to authorize the property to be donated to a charitable organization deemed appropriate by the Board, or to authorize an employee of the district to dispose of the property in the local public dump.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board has determined, by unanimous vote of those members present, that the equipment listed in the Board Report are of insufficient value to offset the cost of removal and/or are of insufficient value to defray the costs of arranging a sale; and
