Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The project consists of minor modernization of the existing classroom and administration areas of the James B. Davidson Middle School Annex, and restoration/rehabilitation of deteriorated structures. The work includes new flooring, new heaters, new ceiling tiles, minor window repairs, painting, new data cabling, exterior painting, minor pavement rehabilitation, and installation of a new play structure. The project will also include the temporary relocation of approximately 177 students and 14 staff from the Laurel Dell Elementary School campus, located 0.1 miles away, to the Davidson Annex campus.

Reasons Why Project Is Exempt: Class 1: Operation, repair, maintenance or minor interior and exterior alterations to existing public structures, facilities, and mechanical equipment involving no or negligible expansion of use, including restoration or rehabilitation of deteriorated structures (e.g., new flooring, new ceiling tiles, minor window repairs, interior and exterior painting, minor pavement rehabilitation). Class 2: Replacement of existing facilities involving the substantially same purpose and no or negligible expansion of capacity, including replacement data cabling. Class 3: Small new facilities or structures (e.g., a new play structure), the installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures (e.g., new heaters, new data cabling), and reasonable plumbing and electrical power extensions to serve the structure. Class 11: Construction or replacement of minor structures accessory to existing facilities (e.g., new play structure, minor pavement rehabilitation). CEQA Guidelines §15282(i): The transfer of students from a public K-12 school to another school when the only physical changes involved are categorically exempt.
