

PART A - Please describe in detail the proposed use of funds (use additional pages if needed).

In the October wildfires that affected Northern California, specifically Santa Rosa California, The Santa Rosa FFA Chapter's school farm sustained significant damage. On October 9th it was confirmed that the wildfires burned the livestock barns, truck, trailers, orchard, vineyard, school truck, trailers, and lastly, an advisors home on the property. Funds from this specialized grant would be used towards the fire recovery, rebuilding, and purchasing the livestock and harvesting supplies lost in the fires. Monetary losses to the program are in the hundreds of thousands. However, in addition to the possessions that were lost in the fires was loss of use of the facility itself for the various crops, livestock projects, events, and home to our staff and our students. Rebuilding will be a long process, as the program wishes to not only replace what was lost but develop new opportunities for our students in the future.

PART B - How will this project improve the local program? (Use additional pages if needed.)

Animal projects have always been the backbone to traditional agriculture programs at the High School level. At Santa Rosa High School we offer career pathways in both the plant and animal sciences. We have always encouraged further growth and development within agriculture education with the completion of a Supervise Agricultural Experience Project. SAEs are designed specifically with the intention of teaching the student a trade/skill, which could turn into a financial enterprise or career-developing project. Quite often that project has been the cultivation of a market animal, or plant/landscaping project. By offering the students a place to raise animals increases the student's literacy of agriculture and exposes many other members of our community to various agriculture endeavors.

The importance of having a school farm facility lies in the demographics of the student population that we serve. The fires have taken that facility away for the time being and as the program navigates the insurance claims we know that the rebuilding process will be more than what the district will receive. Grants, like this will assist in not only rebuilding what was but improving our outdoor learning experiences for decades to come.
