

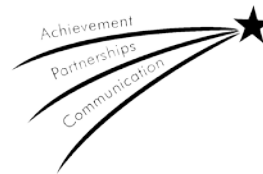

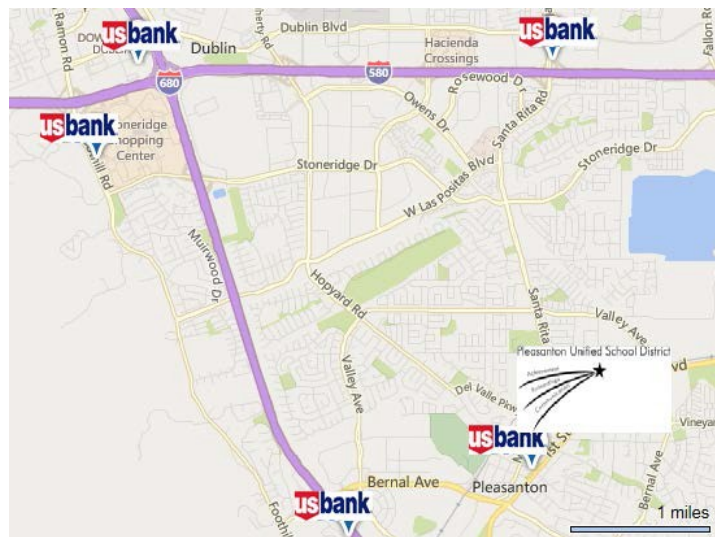

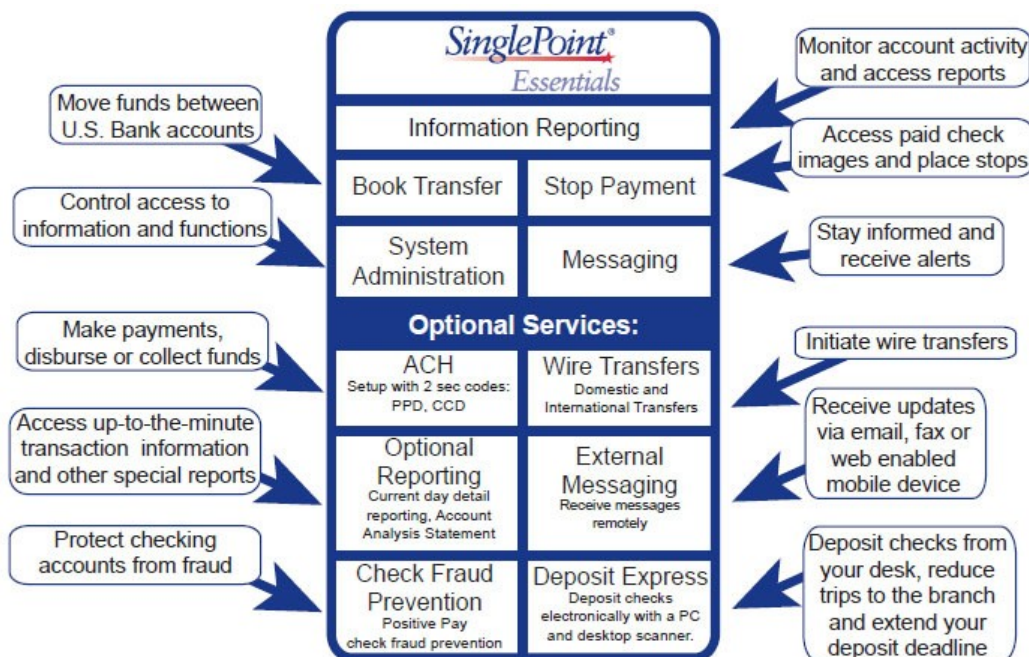

Our remote deposit product is called On-Site Electronic Deposit or Deposit Express. It is a web-based client application that is very robust, scalable and highly configurable. It supports very simple deployments with small volumes and large, complex, multi-user deployments with high volumes. It has highly flexible and robust separation of duties where you may assign functional duties based on your users' roles, where the roles are defined with specific sets of permissions or entitlements on the system. The various users can perform their duties from any remote location provided they have appropriate connectivity and access to the locations system (accessed through SinglePoint).
