Background

The 2016-2017 Budget Act has appropriated a College Readiness Block Grant to local education agencies (LEA).

The appropriation is based on the number of unduplicated students in grades 9-12 with a minimum apportionment of \$75,000 per LEA.

Funds must be spent or encumbered by the end of the 2018-19 fiscal year.

Unduplicated students at LCHS are English Learners, low income, and foster and homeless youth

As part of the plan the LEA must measure the impact that funds will have on unduplicated students and present the information to the state superintendent

Requirements

The funds must be used to increase or improve services for unduplicated students and should align to the LEA's LCAP

Goal #6: Provide a Quality Instructional Support Program for English Language Learners

The plan describing how the funds will be used must be discussed at a regular board meeting and adopted at a subsequent board meeting.
