Purpose of the CA Dashboard

- Provide public access to the state and local accountability measures that align with the eight state priorities
- Provide schools/districts with disaggregated data to determine student achievement needs
- Identify schools/districts in need of support through multiple measures

The California Way

The multiple measures system uses status and change to create a 5x5 grid which produces 25 results and 5 performance levels

Status - Very High, High, Medium, Low, Very Low

Change - Increased Significantly, Increased, Maintained, Declined, Declined Significantly

Performance - Blue, Green, Yellow, Orange and Red

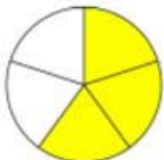

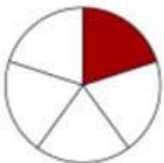

CA Dashboard Measures

- Academic Indicators, ELA and Math, Grades 3-8
 - 2015-16 (status), 2014-15 (change)
- English Learner Progress Indicator
 - 2014-15 CELDT + RFP 2013-14 (status), prior year (change)
- Graduation Rate
 - 2013-14 status and change from average of previous 3 years
- Suspension
 - 2014-15 status and change from 2013-14
- College and Career Indicator (Status only)
 - 2013-14 graduates with CST (EAP) data from 2012-13

CA Dashboard Measures

The March 2017 release is:

- Data our district and sites have already reviewed, analyzed and acted upon - “old data”
- Designed to let districts, schools, and the community learn about the new accountability system
- Designed to prepare for the Fall 2017 release which will have current data
