What Preceded the Passage of Measure X

- Need by late 2000's: Enrollment increasing Districtwide with future growth forecasted
- Measure P: Placed by Board of Trustees on the ballot in 2013 to address growth and needs in other areas such as technology; Measure P failed to get the 55% yes vote needed to pass
- Since 2013: Growth continued especially with planned new developments in San Mateo and Foster City
- Next Steps Committee (NSC): Appointed in early 2014 comprised of community stakeholders and two Trustees



Preceded Measure X--continued

- Next Steps Committee Charge: Solicit public input about various ways of addressing increased and increasing enrollments and, based on that input, make recommendations to the SMFCSD Board
- Next Steps Committee Public Outreach:
 - Peninsula Conflict Resolution Center engaged community members in over 100 Town Halls and Forums
 - PCRC utilized two community wide survey opportunities resulting in over 5000 responses
- Next Steps Committee Meetings: met over 30 times



Preceding Measure X

- Next Steps Committee Report and Recommendations: Provided to the SMFCSD Board in June 2015. Recommendations were to seek voter approval for a bond measure for \$148 million to do 7 projects
- SMFCSD Board Study Sessions on NSC Recommendations:
 - July and August 2015
 - Added one project (new additional gym at Bayside) to be funded by the bond
 - Unanimously voted to place the bond measure on the November 2015 ballot
- Measure X attained a nearly 60% aye vote



Initial Steps after Passage of Measure X (November 2015)

- **1. SMFCSD Board action to complete 8 projects in two phases:**
 - Phase I Projects:
 - Elementary school in Foster City if site could be secured with back up plan to add facilities to existing elementary schools in Foster City
 - Gym and Additional Classrooms Project at Abbott Middle School
 - Gym and Additional Classrooms Project at Borel Middle School
 - Gym at Bayside Academy



Initial Steps--continued

- Phase II Projects:
 - New Classroom Project at Bowditch Middle School
 - New elementary school on the vacant corner of the College Park/Turnbull site for 250 students
 - Additional Classrooms and New Multipurpose Room at George Hall
 - Additional Classrooms and New Multipurpose Room at Sunnybrae
- **2. Sale of first bonds to cover Phase I projected costs (March 2016)**
