Discipline Referral Data for the period August-January 2nd

Summary

There were 40 referrals reported on the school wide referral Google form from the start of school thru January 2nd. Five were in August, 1 in September, 14 in October, 8 in November, 1 in December, 2 on January 2nd. The majority of the referrals were from TK-3rd grade classes. 65% of the referrals had phone calls home, 82% spoke to the principal, 0% had in school suspension, 13% were sent to the blue room, 45% lost their lunch recess and 50% lost their lunch recess. Last year at this same time, we had 60 office referrals.

Summary: The above results were from the most recent assessment in fifth grade and shows how students are progressing towards their mastery of grade level standards. The scores are promising as they show a high % rate of students who are already at proficient in Standard L.5.5 and L.5.4. We were very pleased that the number of students who were far below was at 2% in both standards. Our students in fifth grade are utilizing I-ready reading and the Ready workbook in addition to certain select chapter books to support their ELA instruction. The fifth grade team has partnered collaboratively to design a rigorous Common Core aligned program to meet all their students’ diverse needs.

This past month, grade level teams met and discussed at risk students. Action plans/interventions were developed and implemented. The SST team met and developed action plans for those students most at risk. We held an SST day on December 6th and have another day scheduled for January 24th.
