**STAFF TEACHING ENGLISH LEARNERS**

The Governing Board recognizes that the recruitment, development and retention of qualified instructors and assistants is essential to the success of programs for students of limited English proficiency, also referred to as “English learner” students. The Board shall take action, within budgetary constraints, to provide personnel who are competent to properly assess and skillfully instruct English learners.

**Teacher Qualifications**

Any teacher with one or more English learners in his/her class will possess an appropriate authorization issued by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing (“CTC”).
