- ▶ It has grown to provide before and after school care at 21 sites and to 1, 172 students




Our Mission

Program Overview

- ▶ 80 Annex Employees
 - ▶ 1 Principal on Special Assignment
 - ▶ 1 Coordinator
 - ▶ 4 Administrative Assistants (Billing/4Cs, Enrollment/ASES, Enrollment/Finance, Camps/Absences)
 - ▶ 21 Lead Teachers
 - ▶ 1 Lead Teacher on Special Assignment
 - ▶ 52 Teachers and Assistants



After School Education & Safety Grant (ASES)

- ▶ State grant awarded from Proposition 49
- ▶ Provides subsidized after school child care
- ▶ Locations:
 - ▶ College Park
 - ▶ Fiesta Gardens
 - ▶ George Hall
 - ▶ LEAD
 - ▶ North Shoreview
 - ▶ Sunnybrae



Camps

- ▶ Offered during school breaks
 - ▶ Fall, Winter, Spring, and Summer
- ▶ Components
 - ▶ Enrichment activities
 - ▶ Field trips
 - ▶ Nutritious snack
- ▶ Location
 - ▶ Varies each camp; usually located on 2 elementary sites per camp



Professional Development & Training

- ▶ 2 Annex-wide PD Days
 - ▶ Positive Behavior Intervention & Support (PBIS)
 - ▶ Outdoor activities
 - ▶ Communication with parents
 - ▶ Classroom management
 - ▶ Special Education
- ▶ Monthly Lead Teacher Staff Meetings
- ▶ One-on-one coaching and support
- ▶ CPR Training

- ▶ The Annex engages with schools and District partners to support the need for child care for our students
