# Services that are being recommended for elimination for 2018-19

**Professional Learning Community Professional Development - (\$40,000)**

# Professional Learning Communities

**2015-16 - Professional Development for Site Administrators**

**2016-17 - Professional Development for Site Administrators and members of the Coordination of Services Teams.**

**2017-18 - Collaboration PLC Meetings for content - teachers (Literacy Coaches, RTI, MTL's) to review data from six week data cycles.**

# Services that are being recommended for elimination for 2018-19

**Early Literacy Summer and Saturday Program -(Ramp-up)  
(\$30,000)**

# Ramp - Up

Year	Number of students	Number of students Demonstrating proficiency in ELA	Number of students not proficient in ELA
2016-17 (EOY)	19**	8	11
2017-18 (at T2)	18	11	7

\*\*39 students total, but only 19 attended regularly

# Actions and Services being considered for modification in 2018-19

## **African American Success Manager**

- **Position will be filled in April**
- **Request funds to carry over**
- **Vital role for the response to Technical Assistance**

# Actions and Services being considered for modification in 2018-19

**Reduction of One BHS Intervention Counselor - 1.0 FTE  
(\$91,000)**

# Actions and Services being considered for modification in 2018-19

- **Reduction of EL FTE at Rosa Parks and TO (0.1 @ each site) (\$20,805)**

# Actions and Services being considered for modification in 2018-19

**Reduction of Math Coach at BHS - .60 FTE (\$59,920)**

# Project Unallocated Funding Balance For 2018-19 and 2019-20

**2018-2019 -\$225,315**

**2019-2020 - \$278,075**

# One-time funded - Second Semester

School Welfare and Attendance - BHS (\$39,066)

Restorative Justice Coordinator - BHS (\$60,000)

# Extra Math Support for impacted sites

## Math Support

.20 FTE - LeConte

.20 FTE - Thousand Oaks

.40 FTE - Longfellow

# (Formerly Known as) LeConte & Thousand Oaks Math Support (.2 FTE each)

## LeConte

- 2nd Grade Support Class
  - 15 students (80% unduplicated)

## Thousand Oaks

- Mixed 4th/5th Grade Group
  - 10 students (100% unduplicated)

# Math Data - Longfellow

- 6th Grade Math Support Class
- 14 students (64.3% unduplicated)
- Assessment #1 (Ratio and Unit Rate) results used to form class
