Meets UC and CSU A-G Requirements

In addition to any California state requirements

A-G	Subject	Years	Courses
A	History/Social Science	4	Four years, including one year of world history, cultures, and historical geography and one year of U.S. history or one-half year of U.S. history and one-half year of civics or American government.
B	English	4	Four years of college preparatory English that includes frequent and regular writing, and reading of classic and modern literature. Only one year of English Language Development (ELD) counts toward this requirement.
C	Mathematics	4	Four years of college preparatory mathematics that includes the topics covered in elementary and advanced algebra, and two- and three-dimensional geometry.
D	Laboratory Science	3	Three years of laboratory science providing fundamental knowledge in at least two of these three disciplines: biology, chemistry, and physics.
E	Language Other than English	2	Two years of the same language other than English.
F	Visual & Performing Arts	1	One year, including dance, drama/theater, music, or visual art.
G	College Preparatory Elective	1	One year (two semesters), chosen from additional "A-F" courses beyond those used to satisfy the requirements above, or courses that have been approved solely for use as "G" electives.
	Community Service	20 Hours/year	Volunteering at not-for-profit or other community service opportunities outside
	Internship	35 Hours	A paying position in field of interest.

Subject	Years	Courses
History/Social Science	3	Three years of history/social studies, including one year of U.S. history and geography; one year of world history, culture, and geography; one semester of American government and civics, and one semester of economics.
English	3	Four years of college preparatory English that includes frequent and regular writing and reading of classic and modern literature. Only one year of English Language Development (ELD) counts toward this requirement.
Mathematics	2	Two years of college preparatory mathematics that includes the topics covered in elementary and advanced algebra, and two- and three-dimensional geometry.
Laboratory Science	2	Biological and physical sciences
Language Other than English or Visual & Performing Arts	1	One-year language other than English or one year, including dance, drama/theater, music, or visual art.

Certificate of Completion Diploma

Under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, students are entitled to special education services until age 22 or until one of the below are met to earn a diploma.

- The individual has satisfactorily completed a prescribed alternative course of study approved by the governing board of the school district in which the individual attended school or the school district with jurisdiction over the individual and identified in his or her individualized education program.
- The individual has satisfactorily met his or her individualized education program goals and objectives during high school as determined by the individualized education program team.
- The individual has satisfactorily attended high school, participated in the instruction as prescribed in his or her individualized education program, and has met the objectives of the statement of transition services.
