Summary: Our ELD students were assessed in March on the I-ready diagnostic. Our students are making gains in both reading/math. The ELD students in first/4th/5th/6th grade in math have higher numbers of students on or above grade level. The ELD students in first, third and sixth grade have higher numbers of students on or above grade level on the I-ready diagnostic.

Update on Project A.I.M. High grant:

This month we have begun to receive items ordered via our school wide DoDea grant. Our FOSS hands on science kits arrived and teachers were able to explore them and receive training from FOSS. In May, we will have professional development from the County Office of Education on how to incorporate Next Generation Science Standards using Mystery Science, a district purchased curriculum support. We have ordered 250 chrome books, headphones, and mice and have begun the search for a part time counselor. Our next steps will be the organization/storage of the kits, the purchase of Maker-space lab items and a 3 D printer. Our Leader in Me team has been busy ordering activity books, meeting with a group of students in a “Lighthouse team” and developing a PSA(Public Service Announcement) video to share with staff/students to generate excitement for the leadership training . We have had a teacher come forward to assist with the organization of the kits in addition to parents.
