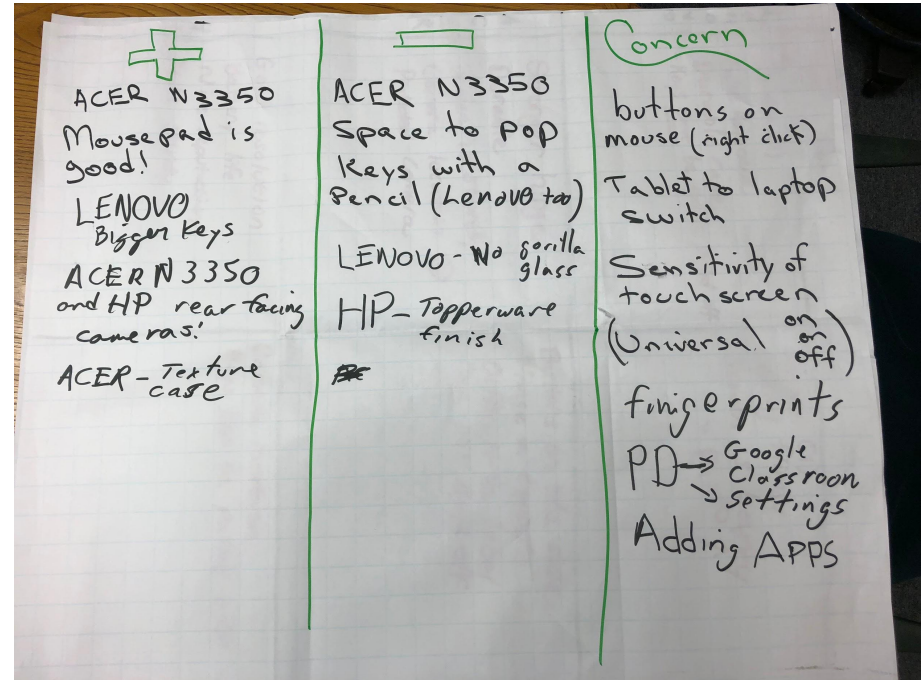
How ... Future?
