1. The "Scope of Services" of the above referenced Agreement is hereby modified as follows:
 - A. **Add Service Agreement No. 2. – Highlands Elementary School**
 - a. **Provided power for light fixtures installed at one of the shade structures**
 - b. **Provided layout for an additional grading to provide ADA compliant pass of travel to the newly installed shade structure.**
 - B. **Add Service Agreement No. 3. – George Hall Elementary School**
 - a. **Provide architectural services for installation of a fire hydrant, as it requested by local fire authority within one year of shade structure installation.**
2. "Compensation and Payment" of our Agreement approved by the BOT 02/18/16 is hereby modified to allow for the additional fees required to implement the above changes. The present fee of architectural services of \$243,530.00 is hereby increased by a not-to-exceed fee of **\$18,545.00** for the scope of services mentioned above as ADA No. 3(refer to the Exhibit A for details) and by a not-to-exceed fee of **\$19,674.00**, (refer to the Exhibit B for details).The present fee of \$243,530.00 is hereby increased by not-to-exceed fee of **\$38,219.00** for a for a fixed fee of **\$281,749.00** for the architectural services.

The new contract amount is **\$281,749.00.**

3. The contract completion date of the project after receiving the Amendment did not change.

All other conditions of our Agreement (and subsequent Amendment(s) set forth above) remain in full force and effect as originally stated.

I. PROJECT:
George Hall Elementary School, 130 San Miguel Way, San Mateo, CA 94403 - Fire System Design for the Shade Structure project. (AEDIS Job # _____)

II. SCOPE OF SERVICES:
On-Site Plans – Construction Documents:
Utilizing the final developed site plan, and the topographic survey by others, CONSULTANT will prepare a fire service site plan based upon Architect's and District's requirements, and final 20 scale construction documents for the George Hall Elementary School Shade Structure project. The project consists of creating a new fire service system from the available public system in the adjoining right of way, including backflow prevention and placement of a new on-site fire hydrant.

The plans will consist of a Fire System Plan with details, notes, and legend. CONSULTANT will perform hydraulic calculations for the required flow, which will show the residual pressure and the available flow at 20 psi per usual fire review requirements. Details will include thrust blocking, and appurtenance details as necessary.

CONSULTANT'S fee includes site visits during design, coordination with the Architect and design team, and submittal to Cal Water Bayshore District. Necessary revisions required by Cal Water are also included in our fees.

Bidding & Construction Administration:

CONSULTANT will answer questions and prepare responses to RFI's. During construction CONSULTANT will answer questions and visit the site as needed and will respond to submittals.

III. COMPENSATION:

CLIENT shall pay CONSULTANT the following fees for the Professional Services performed under II above:

A. Basic Services:

1. Fire Service Construction Documents	\$ 8,000.00
2. Bidding & Construction Administration	\$ 1,500.00
TOTAL FEE	\$ 9,500.00

B. Additional Services:

1. In the event that extra work is needed, and upon written authorization from CLIENT, the following hourly rates for CONSULTANT shall be used:

a. Principal Engineer.....	\$225.00/hr.
b. Principal Surveyor	\$205.00/hr.
c. Associate Engineer.....	\$190.00/hr.
d. Project Engineer.....	\$165.00/hr.
e. Assistant Engineer.....	\$140.00/hr.
f. Survey Assistant (Office)	\$140.00/hr.
g. CAD Operator/Drafter	\$120.00/hr.
h. Administrative/Clerical.....	\$ 78.00/hr.
i. Field Surveys	\$240.00/hr.

C. Method of Payment:

Progress billings for all items of service will be made monthly based upon the percentage of work completed to date. The total fee indicated for each item of service will be billed upon completion of work in that category. Additional services will be billed monthly.

Payment of invoices are due upon receipt. Payments not received within thirty (30) days of the invoice date shall result in a suspension of further work on the project until all amounts are received and the account is current. Interest at the rate of 1-1/2% per month (18% per annum) shall be applied to all amounts due after 30 days of the invoice date.

IV. ARCHITECT & CONSULTANT AGREEMENT:

The work herein shall be accomplished under the Architect & Consultant Agreement dated November 4, 2002.

V. ASSUMPTIONS AND CONDITIONS:

The description of work and associated fees outlined in this Agreement take into consideration the following assumptions and conditions:


- 1) 1) Site Plan and Survey shall be supplied to CONSULTANT by CLIENT in AutoCAD format. CONSULTANT shall be entitled to rely on its accuracy and completeness.
- 2) Design services other than fire system design are excluded.

- 3) Landscape plans, if required, shall be by others.
- 4) CONSULTANT will be provided a soils report containing as a minimum: soil bearing pressure, and ground water table information.
- 5) Any required environmental documents, mitigations or identification of same are specifically excluded.
- 6) Construction Staking services are excluded.
- 7) Construction Traffic Control Plans, if required, shall be by others.
- 8) Structural design, including retaining walls, is excluded.
- 9) Permit Registration Documents (PRDs), including a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), Notice of Intent (NOI), etc., to file with the State Water Quality Control Board to obtain a WDID# are excluded as the site is less than 1 acre.

The above is mutually agreed to this 25th day of April, 2019.
