

FOOD SERVICES

Concept

While the Elk Grove Unified School District recognizes that parent/guardians have the major responsibility for the nutrition of their children, the district believes that:

1. Foods available on school premises should contribute to the nutritional well being of students.
2. Foods available be considered as carefully as other educational support materials.
3. Foods be prepared in ways which will appeal to students while retaining nutritive quality.

The District further believes that guidance and some limitations on food choices in the schools will contribute to the development of eating habits that support good health.

Responsibilities of Principals

The principal of the school shall be responsible for the conduct of students in the lunchroom or eating area, scheduling lunch services so that they are available at the best times, and for necessary custodial services in the kitchen, service and eating areas.

Responsibilities and Duties of Food Service Manager

The Director of Food Services is fully responsible for the cafeteria operation and may assign duties to the cafeteria manager for the planning, preparation and serving of meals, the training and supervision of personnel and for, assisting in the determination of need for supplies, materials and specialized equipment.
