


The completed LCAP Federal Addendum must be approved by the LEA's local governing board.

Upon submission, the LEA must identify the date the Addendum was approved or the anticipated approval date of the Addendum.

LEAs may receive ESSA allocations upon submitting the local governing board approved Addendum prior to the Readers' Conference deadlines.

Funds may be expended once an LEA has:

- A locally-approved LCAP
- A submitted ConApp w/certification page
- A submitted LCAP Federal Addendum



#### **PUSD STRATEGY**

- LCAP (Local Control and Accountability Plan) meets state and federal requirements and addresses eight state priorities.
