












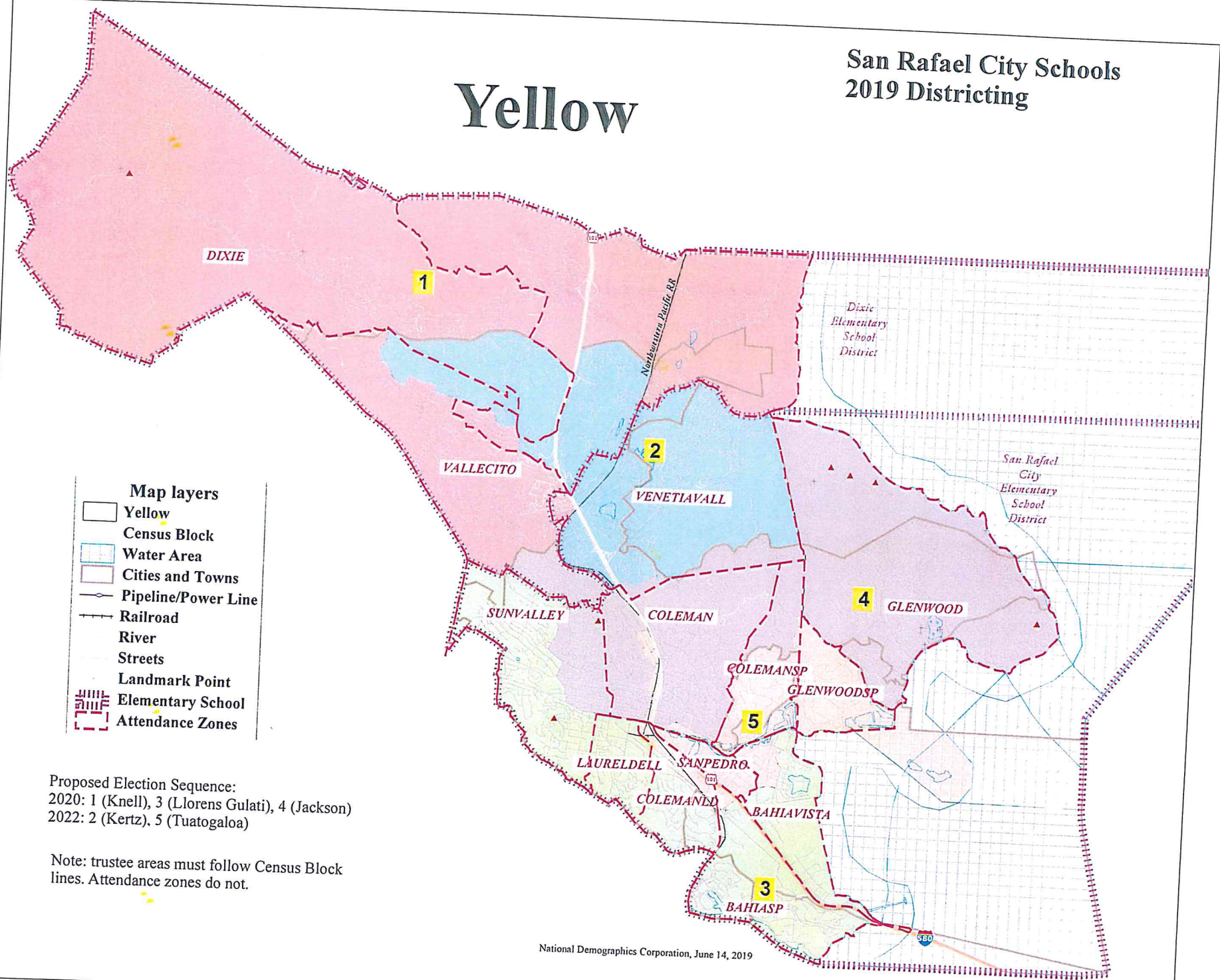

Note: trustee areas must follow Census Block lines. Attendance zones do not.

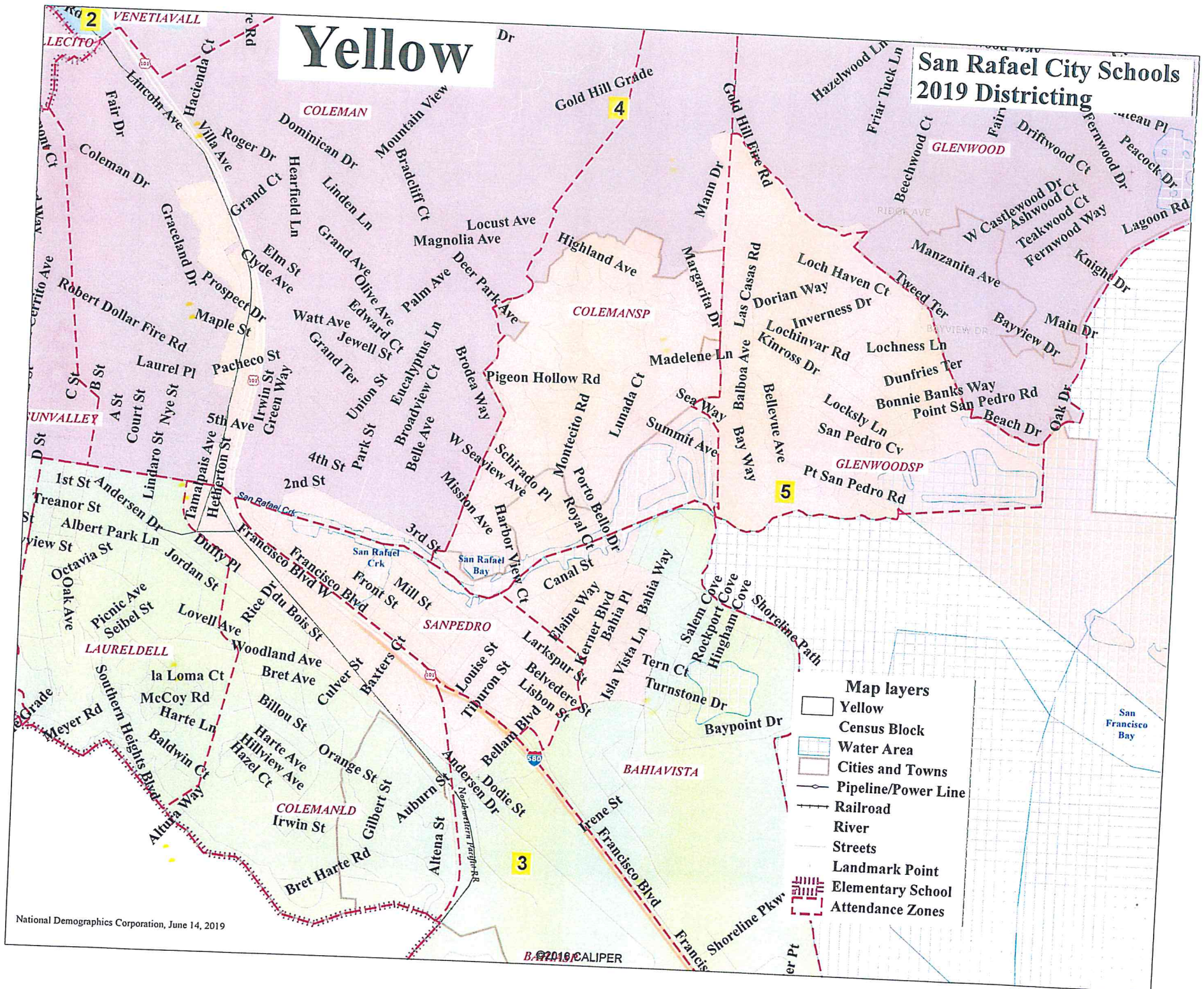
