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Be GLAD Scope of Work

Be GLAD will provide training in the Project G.L.A.D. (Guided Language Acquisition Design) model for a total of 6 days throughout the 2019-2020 academic school year.

A total of 21 participants will be trained by a GLAD certified trainer at the cost of \$1,600 per participant.

In addition to the 6 days of training, participants will receive access to pre-created integrated, grade level thematic units/resources on the Be GLAD website, and will also receive one full example of a *grade level thematic unit aligned with Common Core standards, including Next Generation Science*. Additional units for all Common Core standards with Next Generation Science and Social Studies standards are available separately through Uplevel, Be GLAD's partner company.

Goals/Objective: Participants will understand Be GLAD strategies to:

- Assess various English Language Development levels and support various ELD Levels.
- Differentiate instruction for all student ability levels in the class
- Facilitate positive habits of interdependence so students can work in collaborative groups.
- Facilitate student metacognition so that all students can utilize their learning modality and develop other modalities to support their learning.
- Create an integrated thematic standards based unit implementing District curriculum adoptions.
