



College Going Rates for Pleasanton High Schools





Background:

The College-Going Rate (CGR) is defined as the percentage of California public high school students who completed high school in a given year and subsequently enrolled in any public or private postsecondary institution (in-state or out-of-state) in the United States within 12 or 16 months of completing high school. The California Department of Education has provided this information on Data Quest. The data provided refer to the four years between 2015-2018 and relate to the College-Going Rate for High School Students by Postsecondary Institution Type. This is new information provided by the state.



Data Sources and Methodology:

California Department of Education developed reports based on

- High school completion data submitted by school districts to CALPADS Operational Data Store (ODS)
- Postsecondary Enrollment Data through National Student Clearinghouse (NCS)
 - NCS receives 99% of postsecondary enrollment information from public and private universities in the United States
 - Provided from UC Davis in collaborative partnership with NCS
- Using CALPADS High School Completion Data and NSC Postsecondary data, CDE determined a rate of postsecondary enrollment for students that completed high school during these years

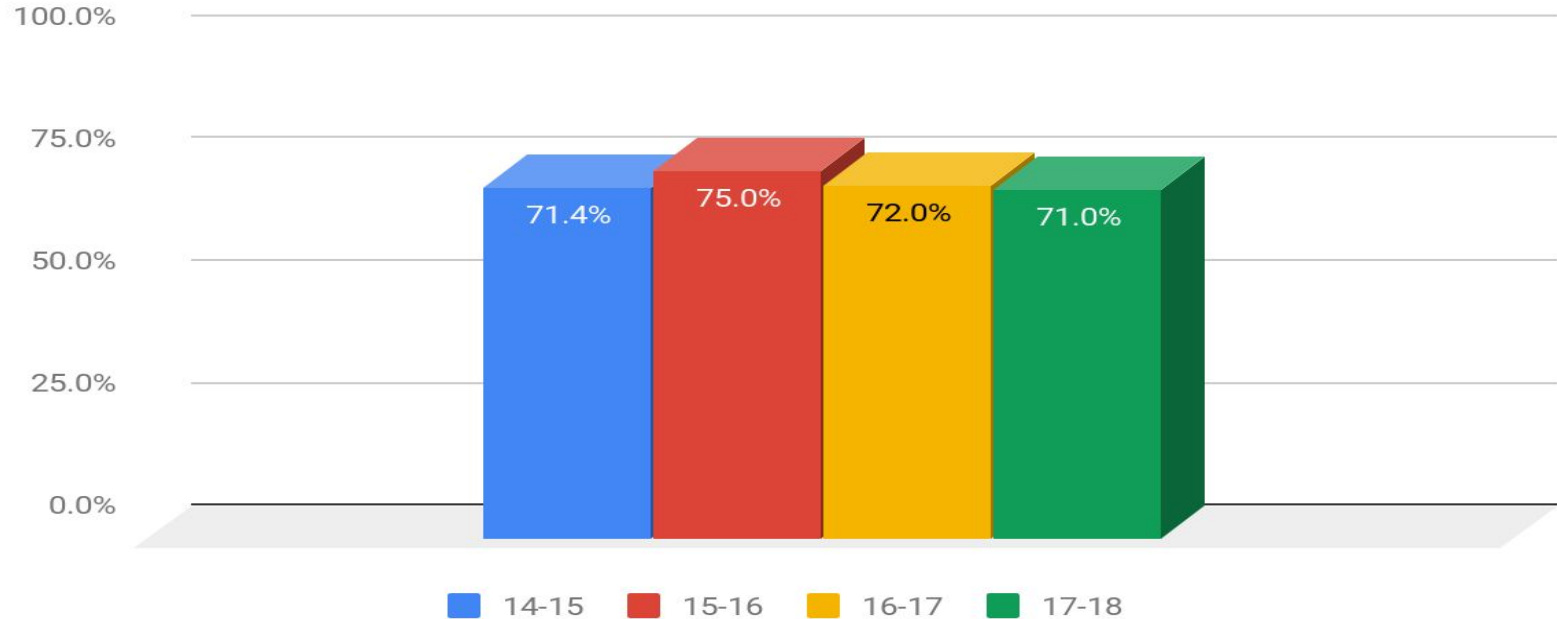


Validity and Reliability of the Data from NCS:

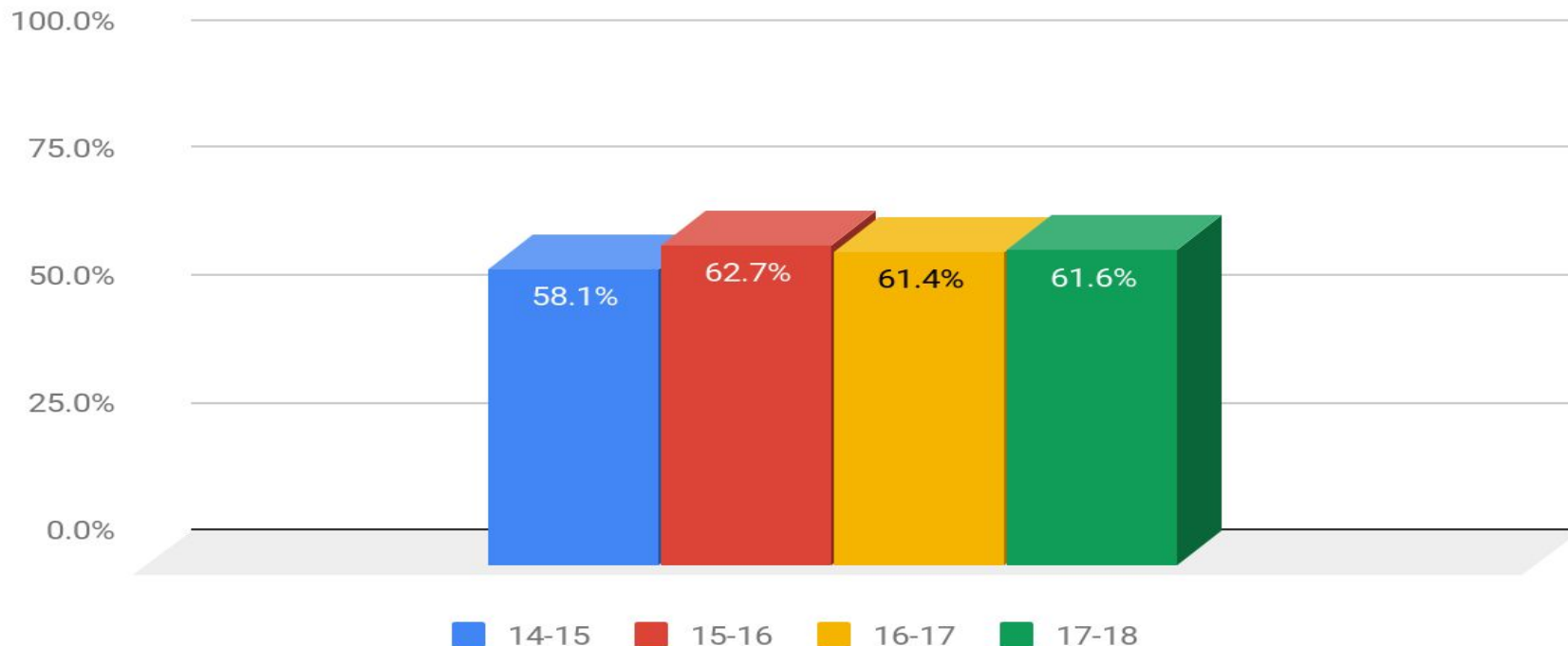
- Meets state and federal accountability and assessment needs.
- Neutral third-party agent for 20 years
- Maintains the integrity of student records
- Nonprofit organization that does not receive state or federal appropriations.
- Compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, The Higher Education Act, and other applicable laws.
- Postsecondary educational directory information records may be blocked by FERPA and may have an impact College Going Rate
 - California's average block rate was 11% over four years



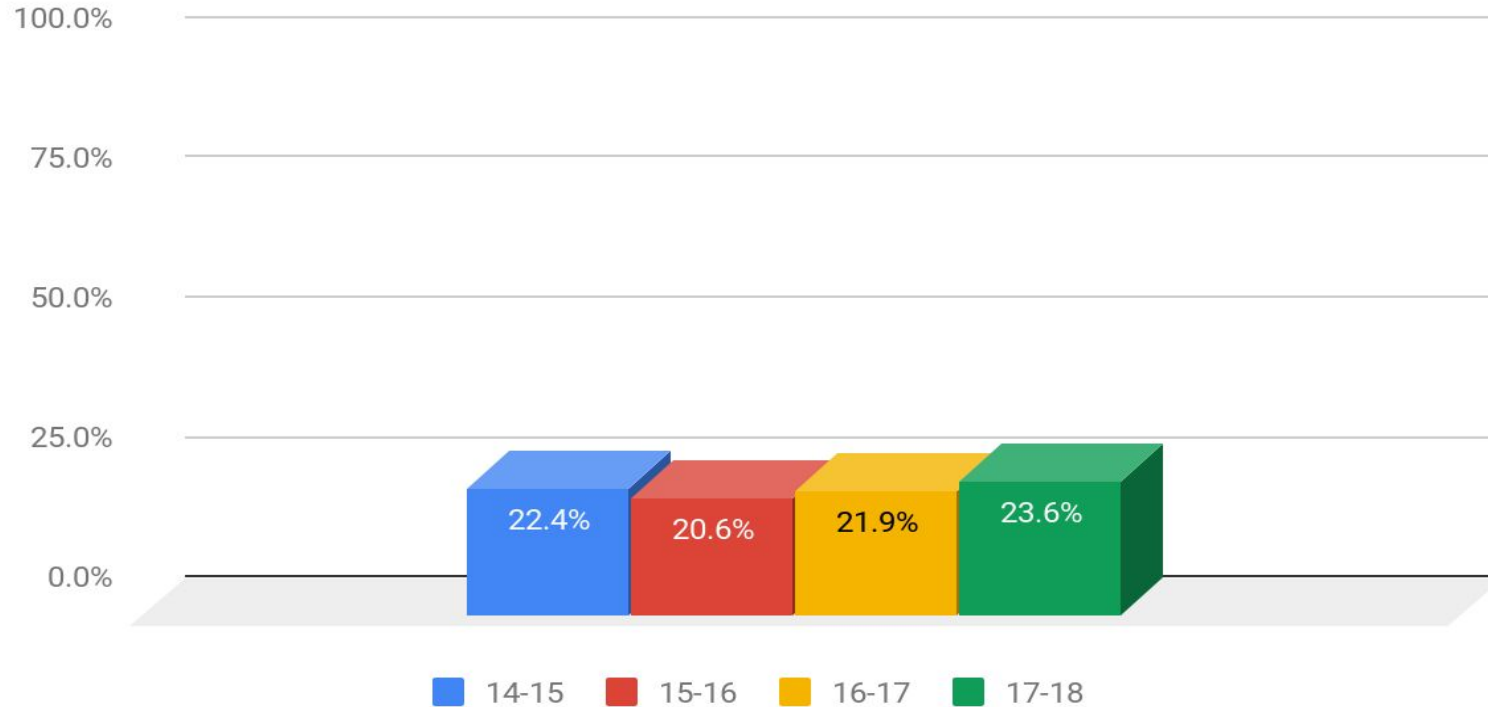
PUSD College Going Rates



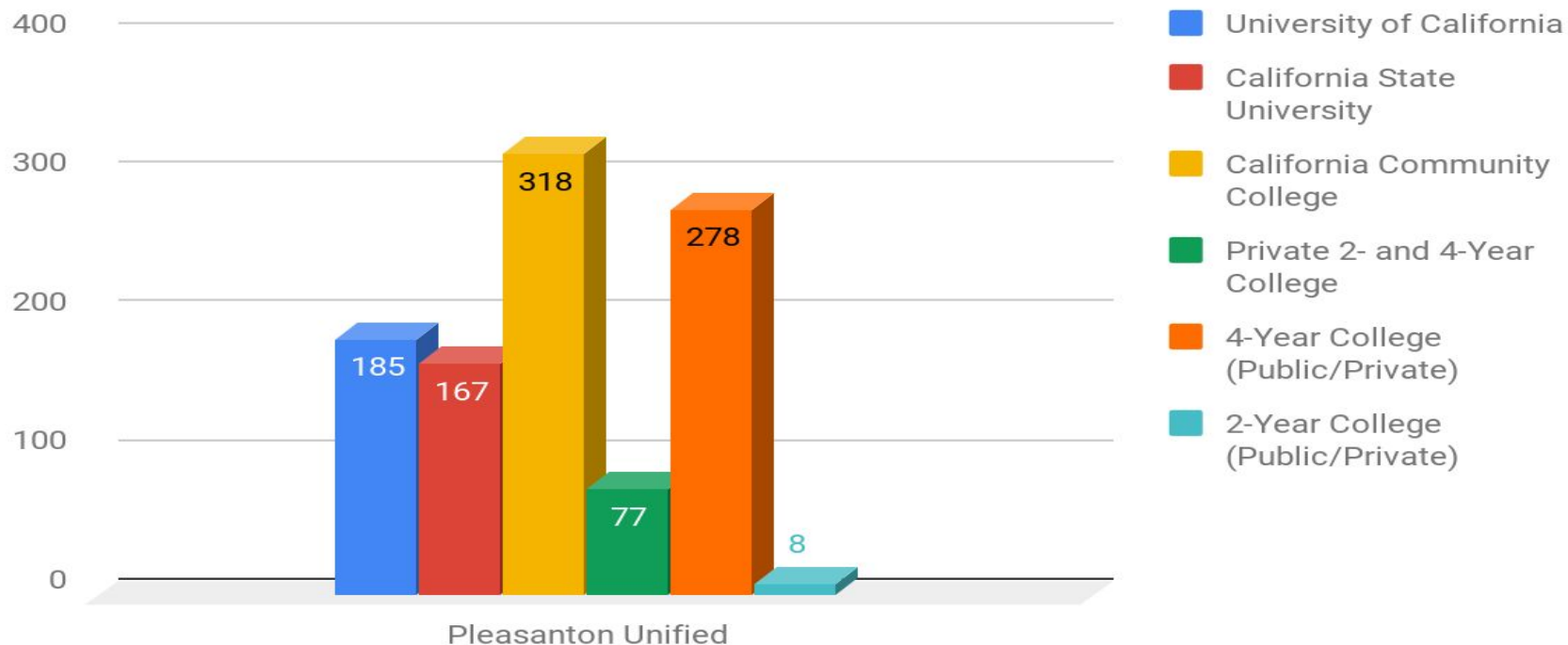
Enrolled in College In California



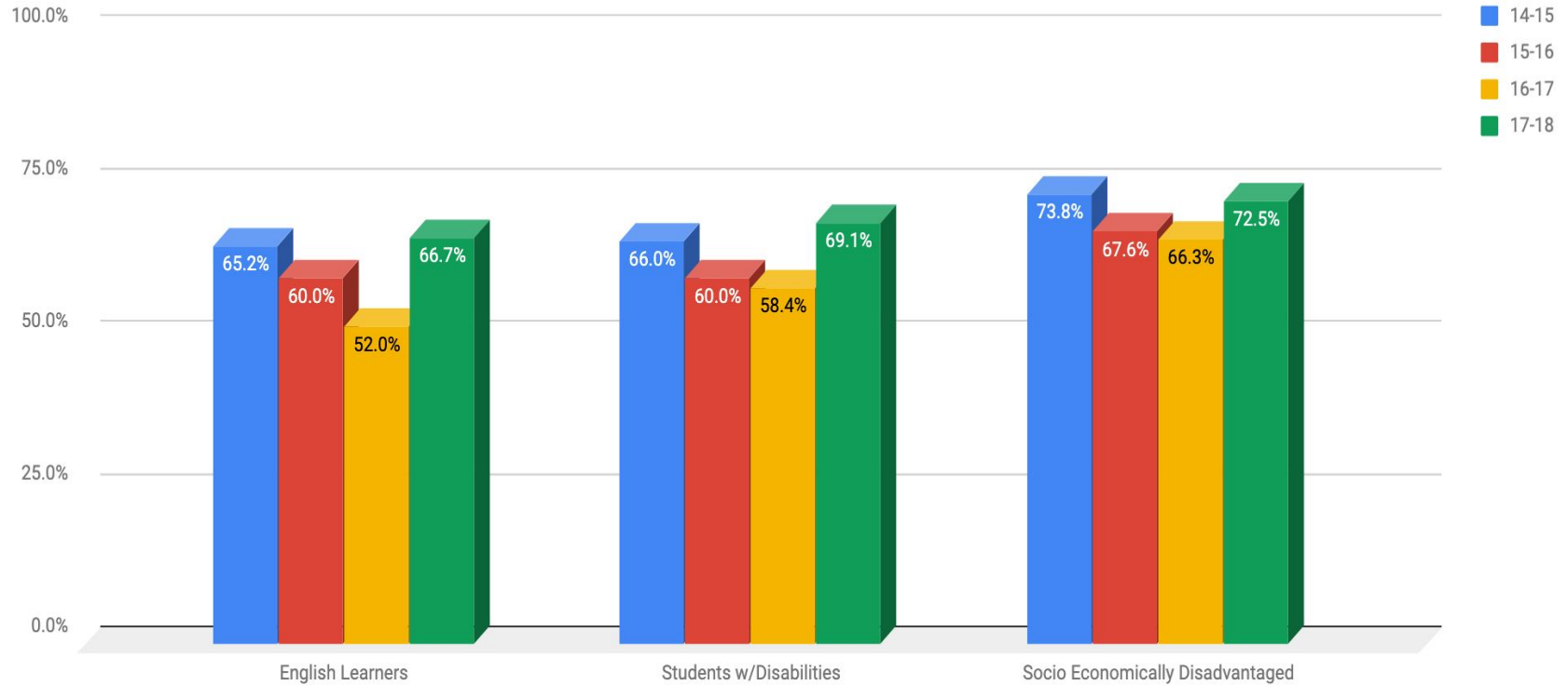
Enrolled in College Out of State



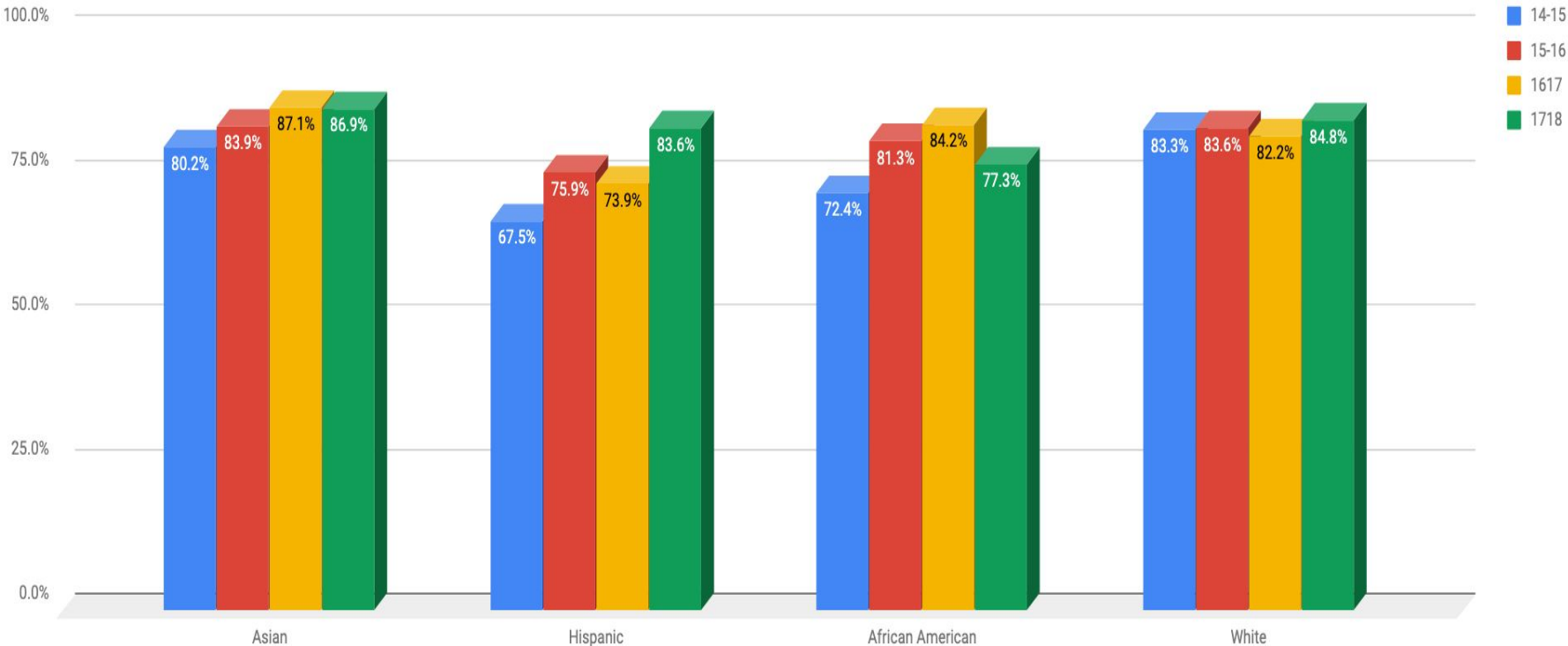
2017-2018 Post Secondary Institution Type (n=1022 students)



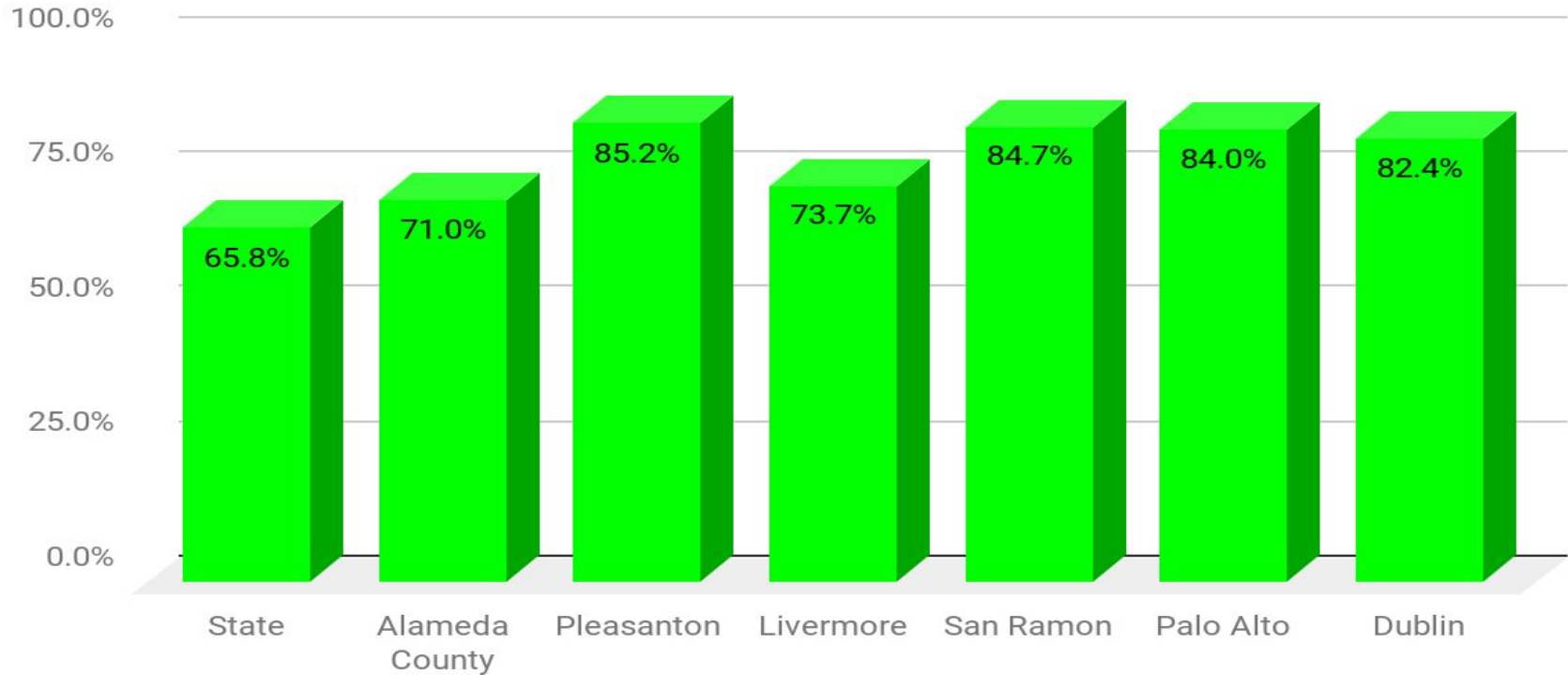
College Going Rates for High Needs Students



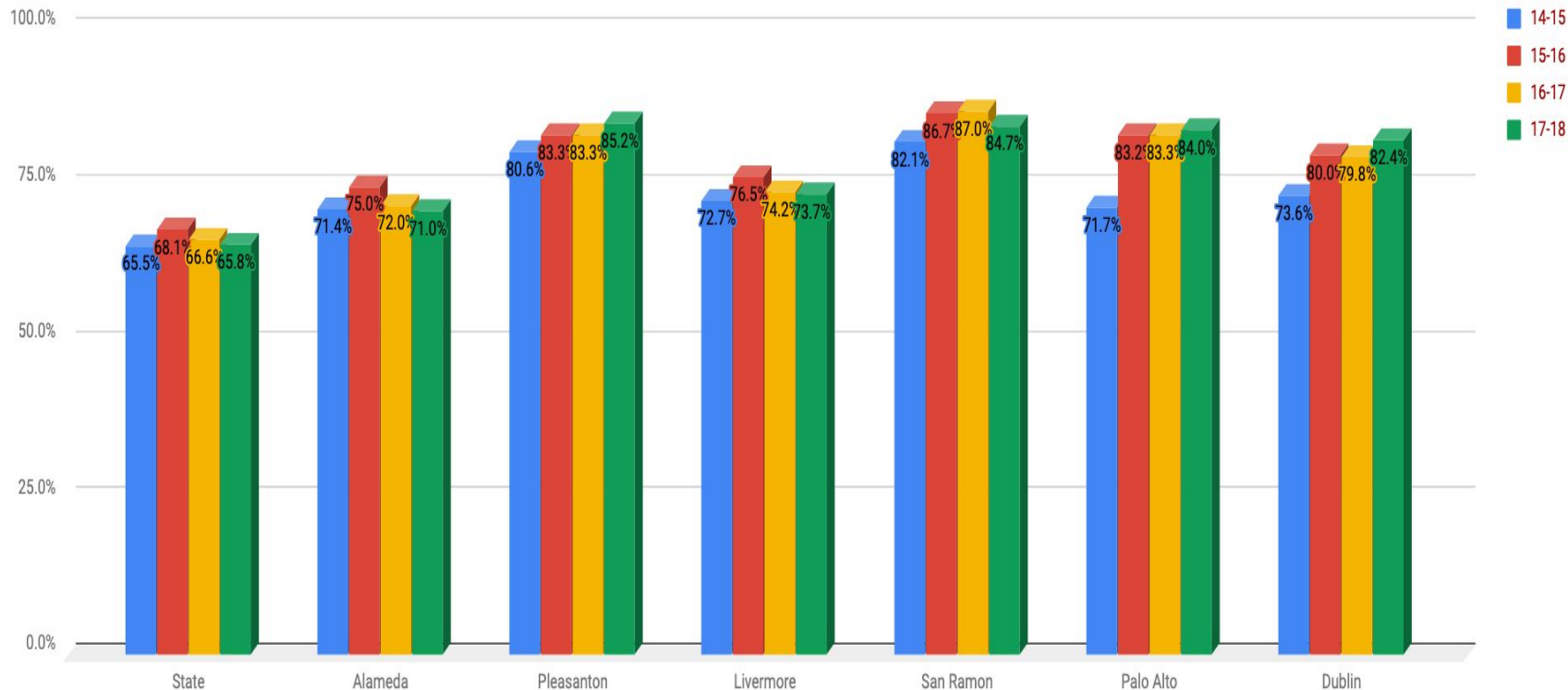
College-Going Rates by Ethnicity



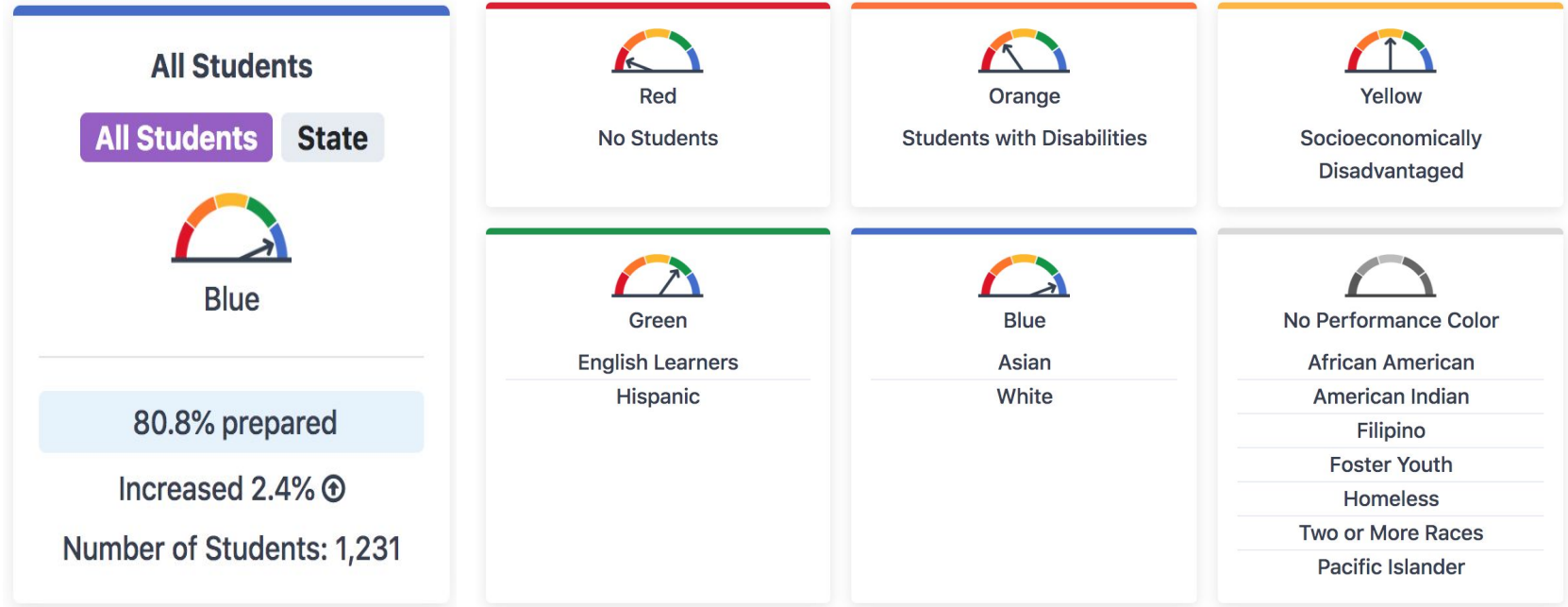
College Going Rates Comparison 2017-2018

California Dashboard Indicator for College and Career Readiness, 2018



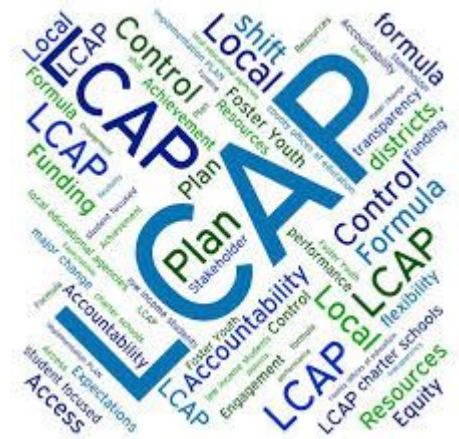
Local Control Accountability Plan Supports for College Going Rates
