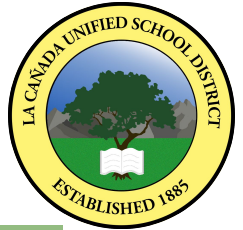

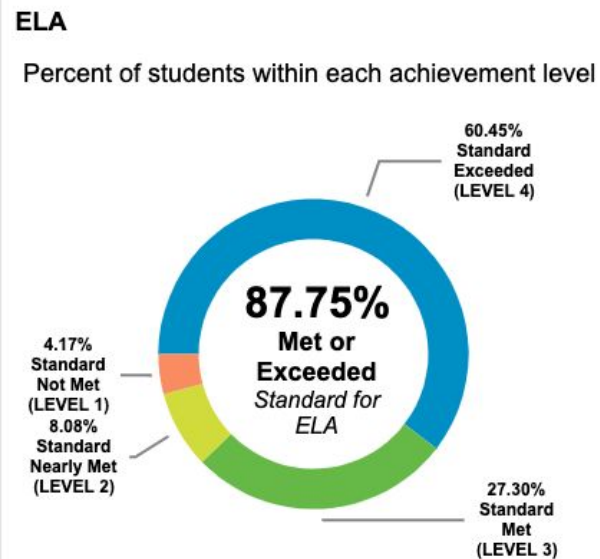
Percentage of Students Meeting State Target: Met and Exceeded in English Language Arts/Literacy



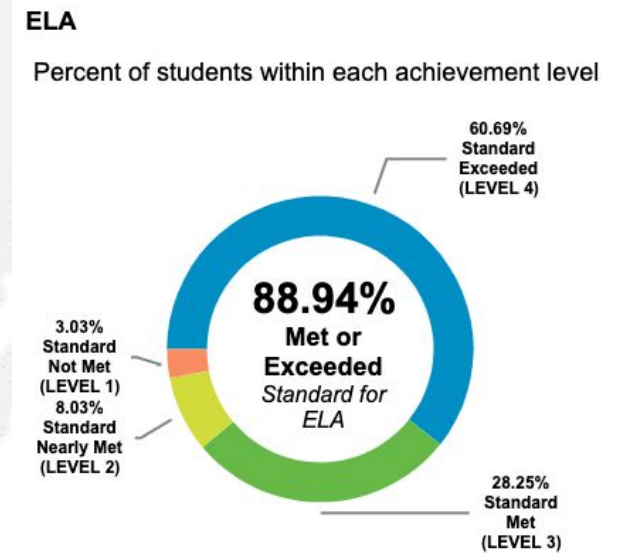
2016-17 ELA Scores



2017-18 ELA Scores

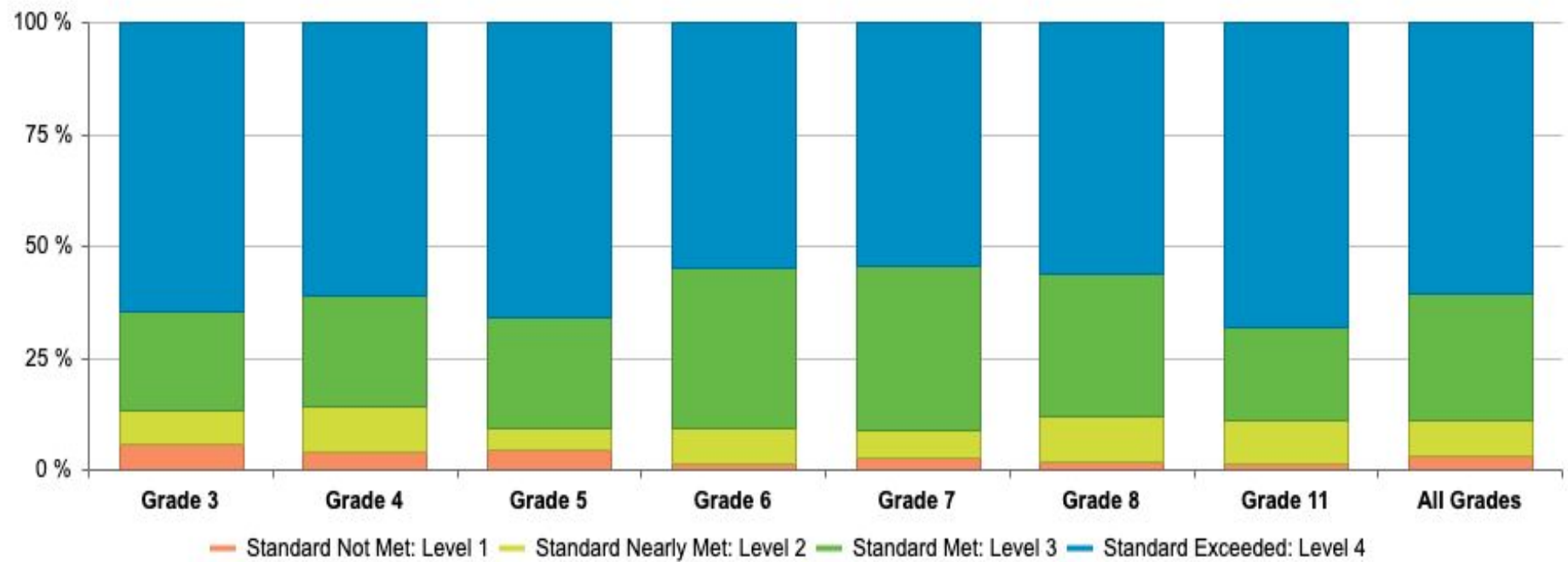


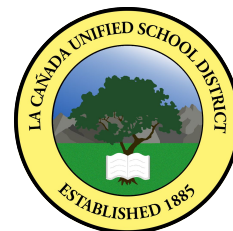
2018-19 ELA Scores

Achievement Level Distribution

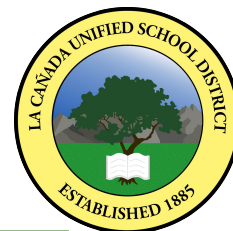

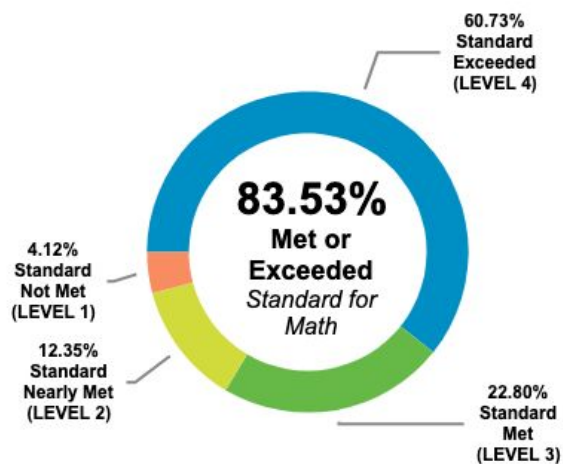


Percentage of Students Meeting State Target: Met and Exceeded in Mathematics

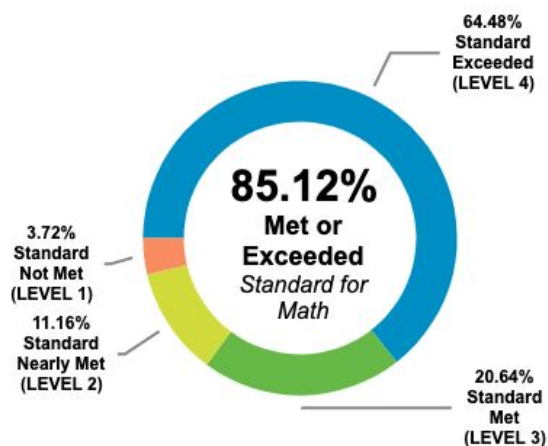
Percent of students within each achievement level

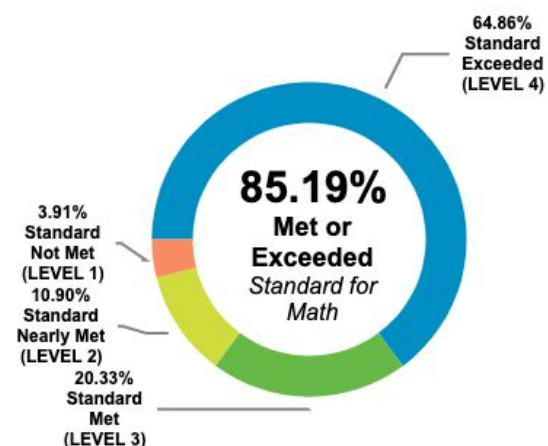
Percent of students within each achievement level

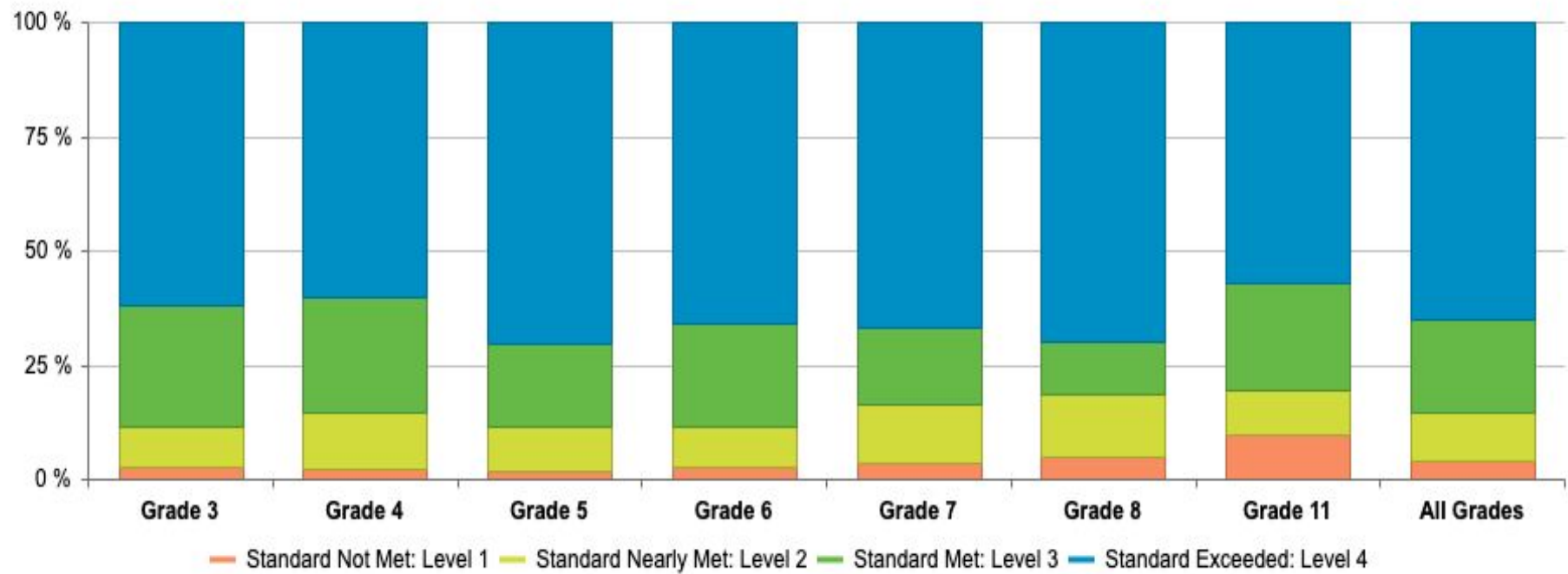

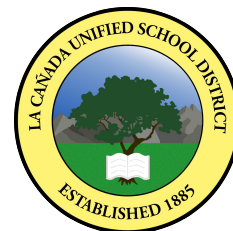

CAASPP:

How do we use CAASPP Scores?

- Focus on improvement--by grade, subject, school, etc.
- Provide differentiation in the classroom
- Adjust pacing guides
- Improve instruction
- Increase collaboration
- Determine GATE alternate qualification
- Determine ELD reclassification
- Compare our performance with other high performing districts to collaborate on best practices

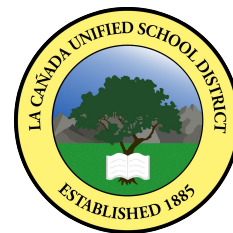
