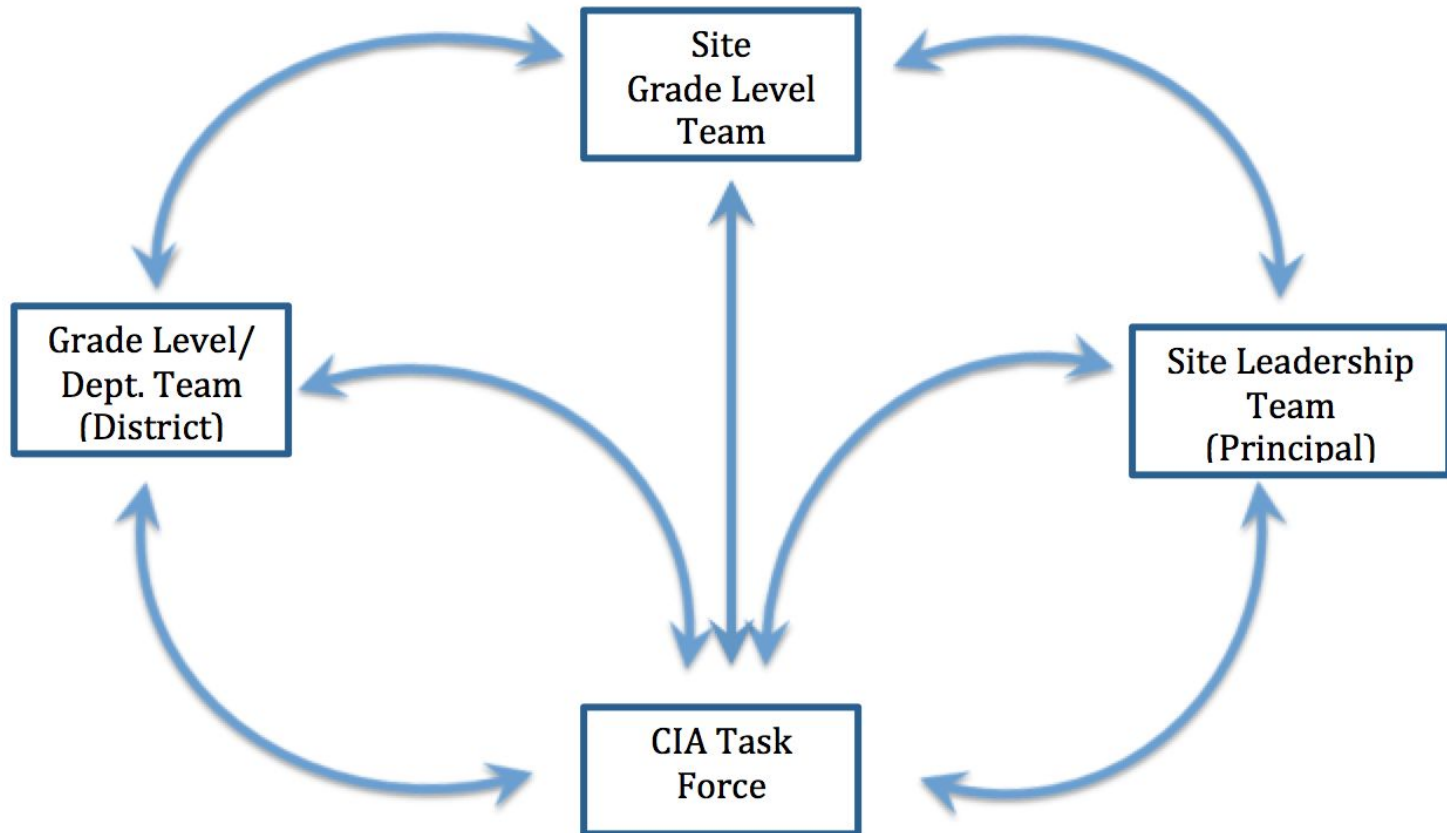

Accomplishments to Date

- ❖ Common Benchmark Assessments in Math and ELA revised to match agreed upon prioritized standards for 2019-20.
- ❖ New report card template introduced and grade entry training provided at Oct. 16 District-Wide Collaboration meetings.

Next Steps

- ❖ Discuss and revise prioritized standards for 2020-21.
- ❖ Gather teacher feedback regarding new SBRC template.

K-8 NGSS Curriculum Pilot

Accomplishments to Date

- ❖ Publisher trainings for TWIG Science (K-5) and STEMScopes (6-8).
- ❖ Pilot materials through December 2019.
- ❖ Single Sign-on via Clever

K-8 Curriculum and Tech Integration

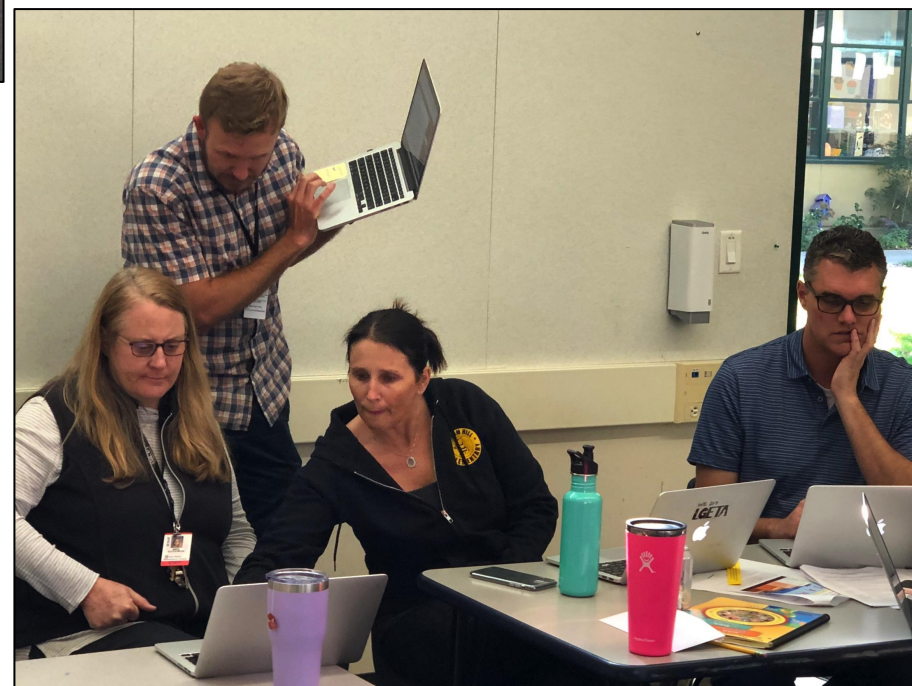
Accomplishments to Date

K-8 Developing Student Success Profile

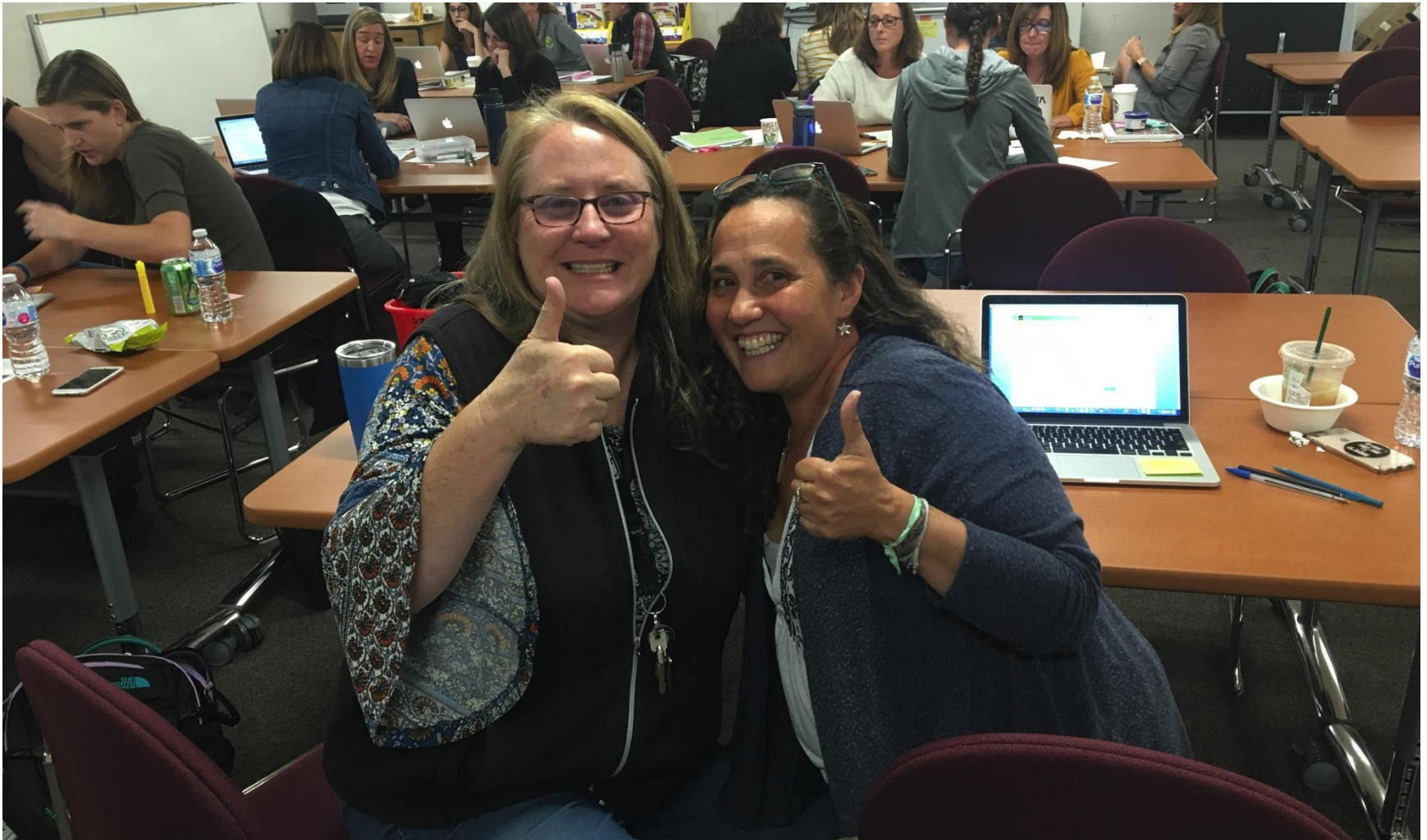
Accomplishments to Date

- ❖ LGUSD Student Success Profile created and adopted by school board (as part of Strategic Plan).

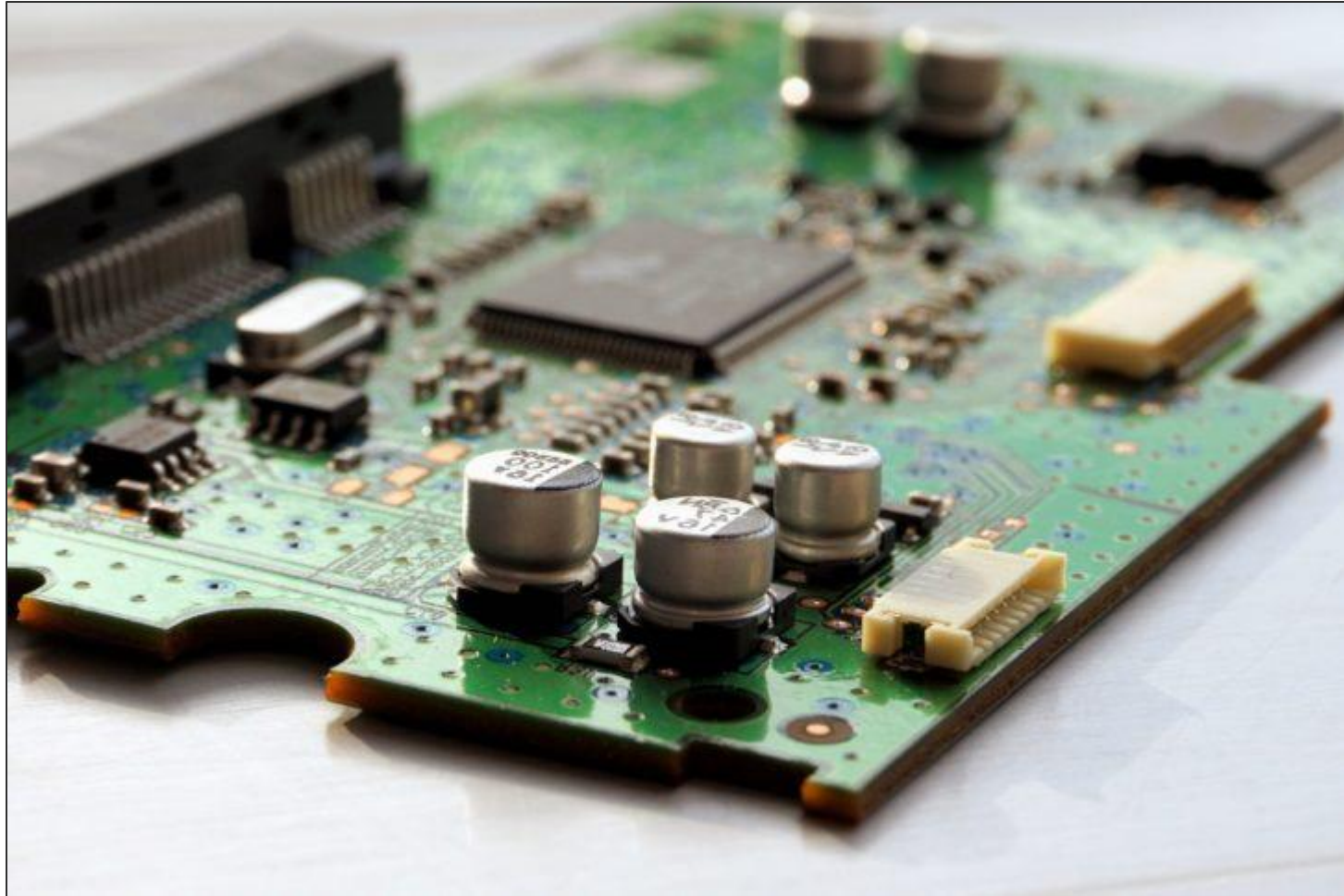

- Next: 20 Fisher Classrooms



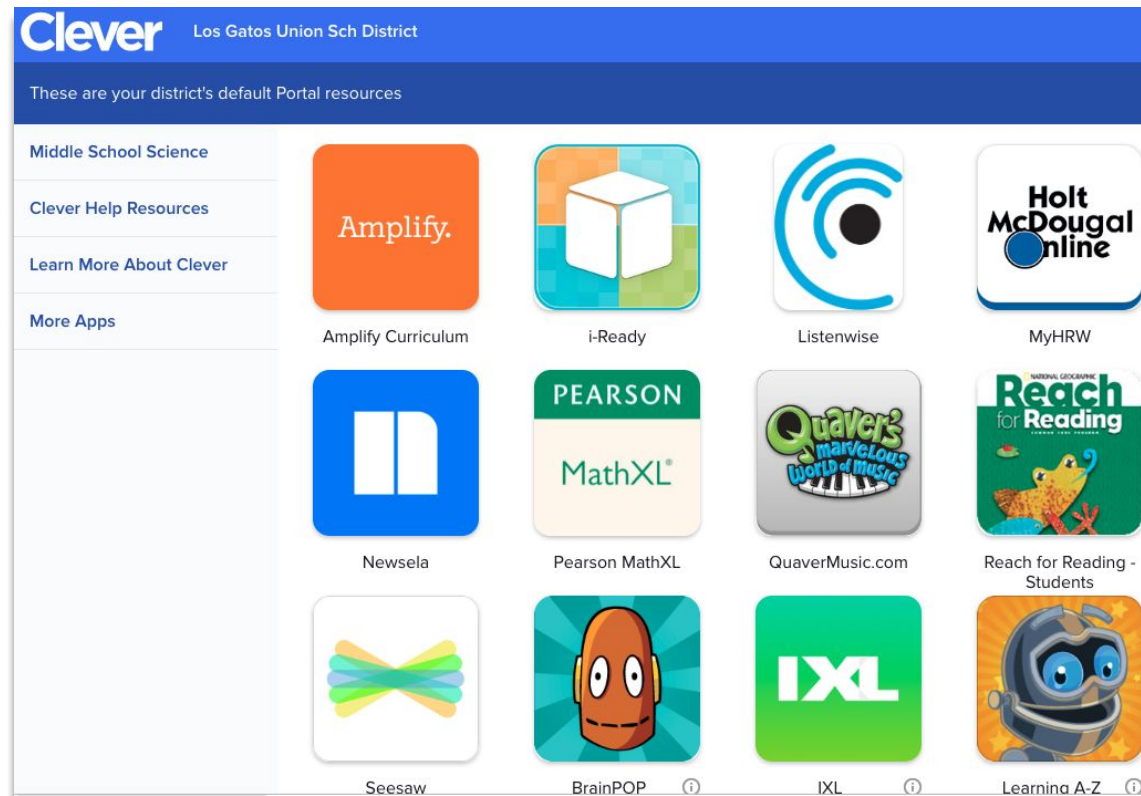
Summer Device Refresh

- **All Fourth Grades** - Refreshed new Chromebooks in carts for all 4th grade classes
- **All Kinder and 1st Grades** - Refreshed new iPads in carts for most Kindergarten and all 1st grade classes
- Supported a new class of **6th** graders for 1:1 Chromebook purchase
