

ICS

Incident Command System

Used by the fire service for the last 40 years

ICS is used to manage local, state, and federal emergencies

Common language

Unity of command, span of control, and consistency

NIMS

National Incident Management System

The National government liked what California did, so they modified it and put their branding on it for emergency response

It is a FEMA approved emergency response system and is the national model

Like SEMS, compliance is tied to reimbursement for loss

SEMS

Standardized Emergency Management System

SEMS was developed due to the lack of multi-jurisdictional training during the Oakland Hills Fire of 1991

SEMS became the statewide standard for coordinated response for emergency responders

State reimbursement is tied to the use and training of SEMS within an organization
