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Capri: Goal 1, Standards

Progress towards goal:

- Prof. Learning Community (PLC)

- Coach, Resource, and Special Education teachers supported core and Eng. Lang. Devel. (ELD) instruction
- Integration of Technology
 - 1:1 grades 2-5
 - 8 Leading Edge certified teachers
 - Google Apps used in grades 2-5

Next Steps:

- Leadership Team
 - Enhance use of Thinking Maps to support critical thinking and writing, with an English Learner (EL) focus
- School-wide implementation of new ELA adoptions and Prof. Devel. (PD) in Guided Reading
- Create a curriculum-aligned STEAM Lab
- Develop rubrics for student work analysis

Capri: Goal 2, Achievement

Progress towards goal:

- Shared SBAC data with staff and stakeholders in the fall
- iReady data: Capri's SBAC scores are projected to increase in math in gr. 3–5
- iReady data: Capri showed more growth in math than ELA in gr. 3–5
- iReady data analysis used to drive staffing and instruction
- Reading Intervention served 51 students
- 5th grade after-school math for targeted students
- Extended Day for students in gr. 3–5 who scored 1, 2, 3 on CELDT

Next Steps:

- Create common assessments aligned to new English/Language Arts (ELA) curriculum
- Summer planning for ELA instruction
- Continue and expand Extended Day support for targeted students
- Provide PD in differentiation to increase rigor for all students
- Partnership and monthly release days with ELA/ELD consultant
 - Identify school-wide essential standards in ELA
- Continue site PD in ELA, ELD, Writing, and tech
- Targeted planning using data and PLC Questions
