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# Lynhaven: Goal 1, Standards

## Progress towards goal:

- Equity Coach support for all teachers
- STEAM lab developing
- Instructional Leadership Team involved in Instructional Rounds
- Grade level release time 2/year
- Integrated Montalvo Arts residency with a focus on Eng./Language Arts (ELA) standards
- Site Technology coach working with all grades to further integrate the use of technology

- Increase enrichment opportunities (i.e.; field trips, assemblies, guest speakers, etc.)
- Increasing site release planning days for PLC collaboration

## Progress towards goal:

- RTI Excel Program with Ed Associate support in grades 3-5
- Monthly Intervention Team meeting with Reading Intervention, RSP, School Psych.
- Formal PLC collaboration meetings
- Lynhaven University provided site professional development
- SBAC preliminary Math results are above the projected iReady math growth in grades 3 and 4.
- SBAC preliminary ELA results correlated with projected iReady scores.

- Increase use of iReady instruction in grades 1-5
- PLC training with a focus on English Language Development for Ass't Principal and ELD champion
- Additional Ed. associate support for Reading Intervention Teacher
- Increase project based learning (PBL)
