
BHS BRIDGE PROGRAM: 10 YEAR ANNIVERSARY





Key Aspects and Highlights of the Program

- Continue to provide intensive monitoring and support for all participating students and families for 4+ years of high school including summers
- 100% of the class of 2019 graduated on time
- 96% graduated meeting the requirements for CSU eligibility
- 94% met the criteria for 'prepared' or 'well prepared' according to the CDE's College/Career Readiness Indicators (vs. 54.1% BHS Class of 2018)
- 100% of Black or African American students in Bridge meet the CCR criteria for prepared vs. 16.7% for the class of 2018
