# Review - Incident Types

- On average, 35 non-school related events occur on school sites after hours each evening.

## Categories:

- After hours home calls
- Non-school related crime

  - Gang / Influence / Activity
- Family crises
- Students needing assistance

# 24/7 Communications Center

- EGUSD came on line as a fully functioning “Public Safety Communications Center” on May 8, 2019.
- Now recognized as regional emergency operations resource by the Sacramento County and Governor’s Offices of Emergency Services.
- The Communications Center operates 24/7 and is staffed by POST certified and trained personnel.
- On July 1, 2019 the Division assumed sole monitoring and control of the district fire and intrusion alarm monitoring systems.
- November 19, 2019 the Division completed the SRRCS (Sacramento Regional Radio System) state mandated P25 Digital Communications upgrade on all police two way radios ahead of schedule.
- All Division Security Specialists are now on the Sheriff CAD system in their patrol vehicles allowing instant and real time info on calls for service.
