- Involve the public in validating previous scenarios and/or identifying new scenarios that could gain the support of the community

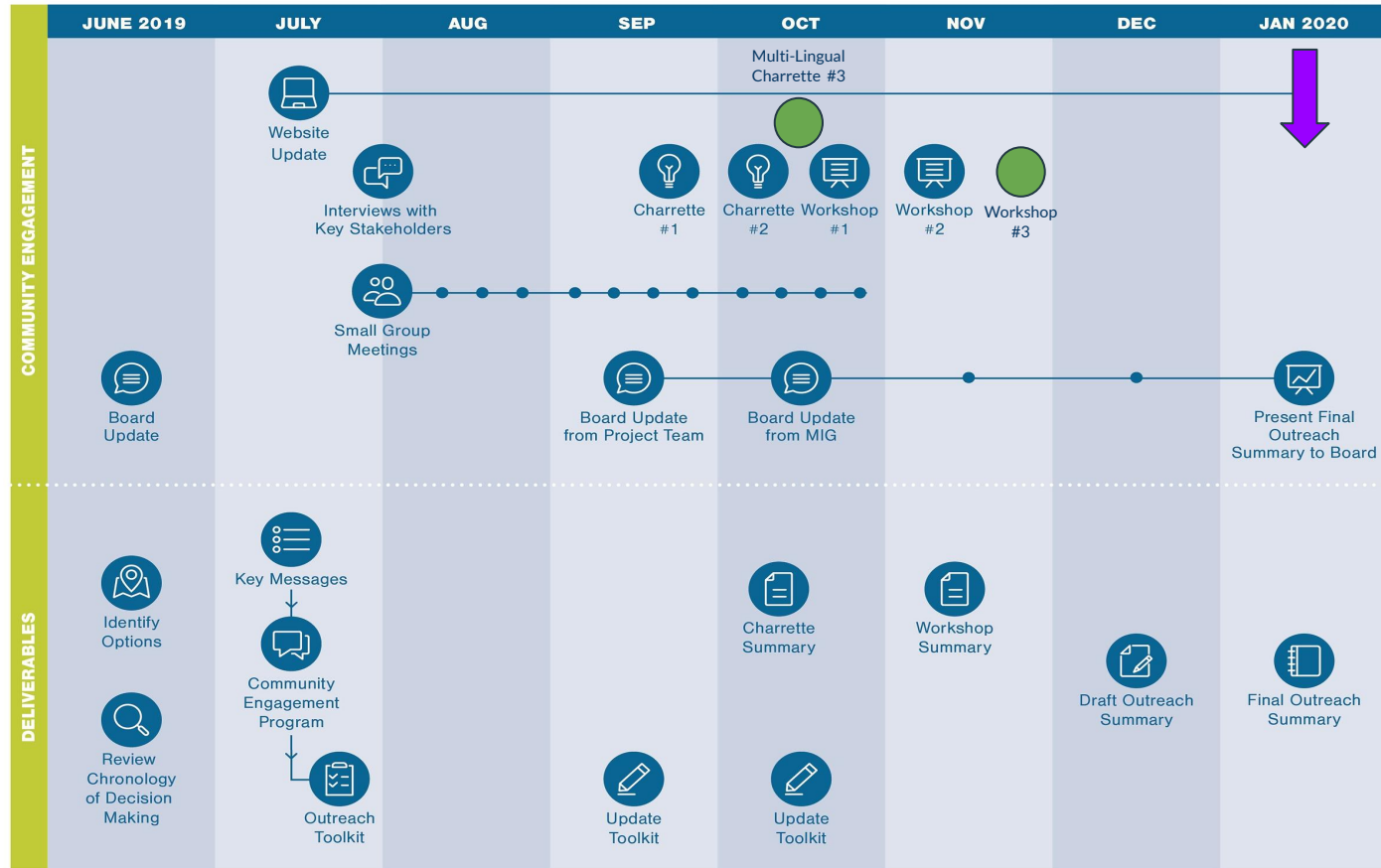


Community Engagement Process Phases

Phase Three Estimated Timeline Goals

- January: Board will receive the MIG Report January 27
- February: Board then determines which options to consider for further analysis considering the Report and community support for various options
- April: Weigh options against the Guiding Principles
- By end of school year: Come to a decision through a series of public meetings and workshops
