## What does LCUSD do during an emergency?

During an emergency, LCUSD's first priority is to ensure students are safe. We then work to secure the school site, which may involve working with the La Crescenta Sheriff's Department and/or the Los Angeles County Fire Department or other relevant agencies. Once we have taken these two important steps, school staff then collaborates with the District Office to communicate accurate information to families.



## Where should I look first for updates and information during an emergency?

Where should I look first for updates and information during an emergency?

First, check your email, voicemail and text messages. Then check LCUSD's website and social media channels, listed on the front of this flier. Remember to remain calm and follow directions from first responder agencies and/or LCUSD.



## What is Aeries Communication and why is it important?

LCUSD uses Aeries communication to send general email, phone and text communications to parents and staff throughout the school year. Schools and the District also use Aeries Communication for emergency notifications. When you enroll your child in LCUSD, your phone number and email address is automatically subscribed to Aeries Communication to receive all District messages. If you unsubscribe from receiving messages from the District or school sites, please note that you will NOT be unsubscribed from receiving emergency notifications.

## Want everything on your phone, at the touch of a button?

You can have all important LCUSD links in one place on your phone's home screen. Simply aim your phone's camera at the QR Code for your school and follow the link. Set a bookmark or add to your phone's home screen so you'll always have up-to-date information at your fingertips.
