- ~~1. The Board of Education recognizes the importance of identifying potential physical and mental disabilities of children at an early age.~~
- ~~2. Effective the 2000-2001 school year, prior to attending school, kindergarten students and first grade students new to the District shall have a health screening by a physician or pediatric nurse practitioner unless the parent/guardian has signed a waiver indicating that he/she does not want or is unable to obtain the health screening. Evidence of the health screening must be submitted to the school.~~
- ~~3. Kindergarten students and first grade students new to the District may be admitted conditionally for 30 school days.~~
- ~~4. Students who were previously enrolled in a Headstart or Preschool program may also be admitted conditionally for the kindergarten year. Upon enrollment in the first grade, the student is required to have a health screening unless the parent/guardian has signed a waiver indicating that he/she does not want or is unable to obtain the health screening.~~
- ~~5. The District's Health Services Office shall provide information to schools for distribution to parents/guardians regarding the health screening and evaluation services available in the community and/or at school sites.~~
- ~~6. Students admitted conditionally who fail to obtain the required health screening within 30 school days or who fail to show evidence of an appointment shall be excluded from school unless the student is exempt because the parent didn't want or was unable to obtain the health screening and a signed waiver is on file. When requirements are not met within 20 school days, a notice of exclusion from school shall be sent which includes:~~

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- a. ~~the date of exclusion and the readmission requirements;~~
 - b. ~~a California Health and Disability Prevention (CHDP) physical examination form; and,~~
 - e. ~~a list of California Health Disability Prevention (CHDP) local providers.~~
7. ~~If the excluded student has not returned to school within five school days with evidence of a health screening or a waiver signed by the parent/guardian, the District's Child Welfare and Attendance Office shall be notified.~~
8. ~~The student may attend school if the parent/guardian submits evidence of a health screening or a signed waiver indicating that he/she does not want or is unable to obtain the health screening. Appropriate documentation shall be entered on the student's health card and the official record kept with the student's cumulative record.~~
9. ~~The Health Services Office shall annually report Child Health and Disability Prevention (CHDP) information to the County Health Services Agency and the State Department of Health Services.~~
