BAB Meeting Minutes

January 14, 2020

1. Introductions

2. Approve minutes from previous meeting

Georgia Pedgrift made a motion to approve the minutes. Dania Mojica seconded. The minutes were approved.

3. Voting item - swap FES to LCAP Budget and IA to Title I Budget.

Our Principal was informed that we cannot use Title I funds to pay for our Family Engagement Facilitator. Therefore, we need to transfer the FEF salary to our LCAP budget and move part of our Instructional Aide budget to Title I. Title I can only be used for Supplemental Funding and much of what the FEF does is mandated by Federal Law, therefore, it is not considered Supplemental. The Principal asked to move the \$57,306 FEF salary to LCAP and \$57,306 of the total \$65,000 of IAs to Title I. That leaves \$7,694 of the IA salaries still in LCAP. This is basically just a switch of which budget is paying for these positions.

Alicia Ford made a motion to make the budgetary changes and Dania Mojica seconded. The motion passed.

4. Summer School update

The Principal informed the committee that we are unable to hold any summer programs at CCLA, including Summer School, due to the construction that will take place beginning in June for Phase II of the facilities plan.

6. Teacher Wish Lists

Due to the fact that we will not be hosting Summer School, we can now look at the Teacher Wish Lists that staff has been working on. We have an estimated \$50,00 balance in our LCAP budget. Our Budget Technician retired in December so this is a rough estimate. The Principal would like to hold about \$10,000 in case of needs that arise. However, this leaves about \$40,000 for the classroom teachers/grade levels to spend.

BAB members were shown samples of Grade Level wish lists from 1st-3rd grade. Teachers are asking to purchase items that will help students be more engaged in class as well as supplemental materials. Example: Ipads for 1st grade, Standing desks in other grades. Alicia Ford made a motion to approve the Grade Level Wish Lists & Dania Mojica seconded. The motion passed.

4. ELAC members/topic: Importance of Regular School Attendance

We tried to hold ELAC elections but no parents were interested in being officers. We are going to hold ELAC/BAB meetings at the same time. Today, we were going to discuss the Importance of Regular School Attendance (Required ELAC topic), however, we will postpone to a different date.

5. Public Comments & Announcements

Georgia Pedgrift talked about applying for grants for a Garden Program and that sometimes grants ask for school contributions. The committee agreed that we could earmark \$1,000 from LCAP towards a Garden Program this year. For future years, we could consider hiring an Instructional Aide to help coordinate a Garden Program here.

There will be an important SRCS Board Meeting on Wed. 1/22. Members of the District Office as well as LCMS & CCLA Principals will be providing an update to the Board on the merge of the two schools. We encourage parents to attend.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30am. We need to reschedule the Feb. meeting to Feb. 18th as there is a Principal's Meeting on the 11th.



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BAB Meeting Minutes

January 14, 2020

1. Introducciones

2. Aprobar acta de la reunión anterior

Georgia Pedgrift hizo una moción para aprobar el acta. Dania Mojica lo secundó. Las actas fueron aprobadas.

3. Artículo de votación: cambie FES al presupuesto LCAP e IA al presupuesto del Título I.

Nuestra directora fue informada de que no podemos usar los fondos del Título I para pagar a nuestra Facilitadora de participación familiar. Por lo tanto, necesitamos transferir el salario de FEF a nuestro presupuesto LCAP y trasladar parte de nuestro presupuesto de Asistentes de Instrucción al Título I. El Título I sólo se puede usar para Financiamiento Suplementario y gran parte de lo que hace el FEF es un mandato de la Ley Federal, por lo tanto, No se considera suplementario. La directora solicitó trasladar el salario de \$57,306 FEF a LCAP y \$57,306 del total de \$65,000 de IAs al Título I. Eso deja \$7,694 de los salarios de IA aún en LCAP. Esto es básicamente sólo un cambio de qué presupuesto está pagando por estos puestos.

Alicia Ford hizo una moción para hacer los cambios presupuestarios y Dania Mojica la secundo. La moción pasó.

4. Actualización de la escuela de verano

La directora informó al comité que no podemos mantener programas de verano en CCLA, incluida la escuela de verano, debido a la construcción que tendrá lugar a partir de junio para la Fase II del plan de instalaciones.

6. Listas de deseos de las maestras

Debido al hecho de que no tendremos la Escuela de Verano, ahora podemos ver las listas de deseos de las maestras en las que el personal ha estado trabajando. Tenemos un saldo estimado de \$50,00 en nuestro presupuesto LCAP. Nuestro técnico de presupuesto se retiró en diciembre, por lo que esta es una estimación aproximada. A la directora le gustaría apartar

alrededor de \$10,000 en caso de que surjan necesidades. Sin embargo, esto deja alrededor de \$40,000 para que las maestras de clase / niveles de grado gasten.

A los miembros de BAB se les mostraron muestras de listas de deseos de nivel de grado de 1 ° a 3 ° grado. Las maestras están pidiendo comprar artículos que ayudarán a los estudiantes a participar más en la clase, así como materiales complementarios. Ejemplo: Ipads para 1er grado, escritorios para que los estudiantes estén parados en otros grados.

Alicia Ford hizo una moción para aprobar las listas de deseos de nivel de grado y Dania Mojica la secundo. La moción pasó.

4. Miembros / tema de ELAC: importancia de la asistencia regular a la escuela

Intentamos hacer elecciones de ELAC pero ningún padre estaba interesado en ser oficial.

Vamos a tener reuniones ELAC / BAB al mismo tiempo. Hoy íbamos a discutir la importancia de la asistencia regular a la escuela (tema obligatorio de ELAC), sin embargo, pospondremos a una fecha diferente.

5. Comentarios públicos y anuncios

Georgia Pedgrift habló sobre la solicitud de becas para un programa de jardinería y que a veces las becas solicitan contribuciones escolares. El comité acordó que podríamos destinar \$1,000 del LCAP a un programa de jardinería este año. Para los años futuros, podríamos considerar contratar a un asistente de instrucción para ayudar a coordinar un programa de jardinería aquí.

Habrà una importante reunión de la mesa directiva de SRCS el miércoles. 1/22. Los miembros de la Oficina del Distrito, así como las Directoras de LCMS y CCLA proporcionarán una actualización a la Junta sobre la fusión de las dos escuelas. Alentamos a los padres a asistir.

Se levantó la sesión a las 9:30 a.m. Necesitamos reprogramar la reunión de febrero para el 18 de febrero, ya que hay una reunión de directores el 11.
