RESOLUTION 2019-2020.28

WHEREAS, the children of Alameda County are our future and will provide the leadership, creativity, and productivity to sustain the quality of life in our County; and

WHEREAS, research shows that a child's brain develops most dramatically during the first five years of life, and this critical period is a window of opportunity to lay the foundation for their education and their future; and

WHEREAS, children need access to quality early educators and child care programs to nurture them during this critical period of their development; and

WHEREAS, only 44% of Alameda County children enter kindergarten fully ready for school; and

WHEREAS, investing in high quality early education yields a high return on investment of up to 13%; and

WHEREAS, Measure C will enable the provision of high quality child care and early education services to low and middle-income children in Alameda County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved, that the Pleasanton Unified School District supports the Children's Health and Child Care Initiative for Alameda County, titled Measure C on the March 3, 2020 Primary Election Ballot.
