Disneyland, Anaheim CA, March 12-13, 2020. Lewis Middle School students Grades 7-8. Leadership students will participate in a Disneyland Youth Education Series program at the park. 27 female and 9 male students will attend. 6 female and 1 male chaperones will attend. Funding source: ASB Leadership. Total cost of trip: \$6,400. Average cost per student: \$177.78 (no student fees required).

Dinuba CA, March 13-14, 2020. PRHS students Grades 9-12. FFA Veterinary Science contest. 4 female students will attend. 1 female chaperone will attend. Funding source: FFA Boosters-hotel/transportation, FFA-registration. Total cost of trip: \$460. Average cost per student: \$165 (no student fees required).

FFA State Conference, Anaheim CA, April 23-26, 2020. PRHS students Grades 9-10. Participate in State Delegate workshop, vote on California FFA issues. Attend general sessions and listen to keynote and inspirational speakers. 14 female student will attend. 2 female chaperones will attend. Funding source: FFA Boosters-hotels/transportation, FFA-registrations/subs, AIG-Per-Diem. Total cost of trip: \$11,295. Average cost per student: \$806.79 (no student fees required).

Disneyland/California Adventure, Anaheim, CA, April 28-29, 2020. PRHS students Grades 9-12. Attend workshop in a Disney recording studio with professional recording engineer. 26 female and 14 male students will attend. 2 female and 1 male chaperones will attend. Funding source: ASB Choir. Total cost of trip: \$7,000. Average cost per student: \$175 (no student fees required).

Disneyland Studios, Anaheim CA, May 7-8, 2020. Flamson Middle School students Grades 6-8. Record music at a Disney studio. 57 female and 28 male students will attend. 3 female and 2 male chaperones will attend. Funding source: ASB. Total cost of trip: \$8,500. Average cost per student: \$100 (no student fees required).

Universal Studios, Universal City CA, May 28-29. PRHS students Grade 12. Senior Grad Night trip. 150 female and 150 male students will attend. 10 female and 10 male chaperones will attend. Funding source: Students attending trip. Total cost of trip: \$62,542. Average cost per student: \$208.48 (student fees required)
