

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Purpose of Summer Programs

To extend the school year in order to provide enrichment and academic support for students.



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Overview of Summer Programs

All programs will be offered via **Distance Model**

- June 4 – June 30
- 19 Instructional Support Days
- 20 Instructional Support Days for Extended School Year (ESY)
- 1 Teacher Work Day



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Summer Programs 2020

- K-6 Summer Remediation
- 7-12 Credit Recovery
- K-7 SWUN Math Support
- K-12 ESY
- Enrichment



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K-6 Summer Remediation

- Distance Model using **Freckle™** by Renaissance Learning.
- Goal = provide **teacher supported learning** for up to 3,000 students.
- Program provides **research-based lessons** for the student to work on **independently** based on their diagnostic placement.
- Focus on **ELA and Math**



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K-6 Summer Remediation

- Teachers are scheduled to support each day of Summer School.
- Provide support to families to **access program** and complete placement test.
- **Monitor** student progress and achievement.
- Provide **guidance** to struggling students and their parents.



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K-6 Summer Remediation

- Students will be **recommended** by their teachers and site admin.
- Student/parent commitment to participate.
- Teachers will receive **virtual training** on the program.
- **Freckle™** will be available for **ALL** students in grades K-7, without teacher support, from mid-May to August.



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7-12 Credit Recovery

- Distance Model using the **APEX** system.
- Students needing to remediate a grade for **credit recovery** will be invited to participate.
- AM session and PM session offered daily.
- Teacher available for the student and to monitor student progress.



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Swun Math Summer Program

- Distance Model following the **SWUN Math** guidelines for Distance Learning.
- Students **invited to participate** based on teacher recommendation.
- Teachers provide lesson through **Schoology** utilizing SWUN video lesson/teacher lesson.
- Teacher provides **support and feedback** to the students regarding lesson.
- Initial lessons focus on **review**; later lessons provide **preview** of next level.



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Summer Enrichment

Provide summer enrichment opportunities, K-8

- Thematic Units that include STEAM, Physical Activity, History, & Social Emotional learning.
- June 3, 2020
- Distance model accessed through District Webpage



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Summer Enrichment

- Eight self-paced thematic units with links to virtual field trips and hands-on activities
- Ocean, Environment, Travel in Time, At the Movies, Fashion, Earth, & Space, Around the World
- Coding Course
- Lego and Reading Challenges
