

2020-2021 Planning Survey: Results

Escalon Unified School District

Background:

- Survey seeking parent input regarding school reopening preferences accepted response from Friday 05/29/2020 through Friday 06/05/2020
- Survey was published in both English and Spanish
- Total of 990 responses were collected
- Respondents reported having students enrolled across all EUSD school sites and all grade levels






If you plan on sending your child(ren) to school which of the following would you like to see in place? (All that apply)




If your child(ren) currently ride the bus and you are able to send your child(ren) to school in August, how would you elect to transport your children?

Narrative Input Analysis (Trends):

- Consistent with quantitative survey responses, narrative input indicated that a portion of respondents wanted EUSD to follow CDC guidelines if and when reopening schools and also heavily consider the:
 - Use of hand sanitizer/soap in all classrooms and restrooms
- Responses were split regarding the use of student and teacher masks with some respondents in favor of mask usage while other respondents completely opposed to student mask usage



Narrative Input Analysis (Trends):

- Responses were split amongst the continued implementation of Distance Learning and the reopening of schools; with a greater percentage of respondents indicating a preference for physical reopening of school sites.
- Respondents provided considerations for alternative school reopening measures including but not limited to:
 - Split School days for different groups (morning vs. afternoon)
 - Alternative Day schedules
 - Options of Distance Learning and physical school attendance left to parents



Next Steps:

- Consult EUSD School Board
- Consult EUSD employee bargaining groups (e.g. EUTA, CSEA)
- Consult CDC guidelines; CDE guidelines; US Department of Education guidelines; CDPH guidelines; and Governor's Executive orders
- Develop EUSD School Reopening plan and share with stakeholders
