PURPOSE OF THE COMMITTEE

The La Cañada Unified School District's Board of Education voted in June 2017 to place a \$149 million bond measure on the November 7, 2017 ballot. The community approved Measure LCF with a 70.99% YES vote to repair and modernize classroom and school facilities, including fixing deteriorating roofs, plumbing and electrical systems, improving student safety and campus security systems, upgrading and expanding classrooms, science labs, career-training facilities and increasing instructional technology to support advanced programs in math, science, engineering, technology and the arts, and to construct, acquire, repair classrooms, sites, facilities and equipment.

As set forth in Prop 39, the purpose of the Measure LCF Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee is to review and report on the proper expenditures of taxpayers' money for school construction on the Measure LCF bond projects.

The Oversight Committee conducted quarterly business meetings that included review of facilities projects and project expenditures.
