OVERALL RESPONSIBILITY

Under general supervision, recover, educate, and graduate students that meet MVA program eligibility criteria. Teachers work with a caseload of students across multiple academic disciplines to support each student to earn a high school diploma. In addition, instructional technology and the use of computer-adaptive curriculum are main components of the Academy.

Basic Teacher Work Year

Teachers will instruct for 2 three-hour blocks with 30 students in each block.

Students will attend for three hours and have two hours of independent study or off campus instruction.
Teachers will be guaranteed the contracted number of days during the school year.
