Chemicals, Radiation & Breast Cancer

Exposures:

Carcinogens

Hormone Disruptors

Physical agents

Description:

Linked specifically to cancer

Disrupt the body's hormones

For example, radiation

Risk factors for disease do not act in isolation

- Mixtures and Low doses

Non-Toxic Cleaning

What's in our products?

Exposures:

- Exposed to cleaning products chemicals daily
- Detected in urine, breast milk, blood (incl. umbilical cord)
- Workers have highest exposure – Women, People of Color
- EPA: “contributes to higher pollutant levels inside homes”

Health Impacts:

- Asthma, Skin Irritation
- Cancer
- Birth Defects
- Other Reproductive and Developmental Harm



BCPP Red List

- Highlights chemicals that pose serious chronic health concerns including cancer, hormone disruption, and reproductive and developmental harm.
- Restricted substances list of chemicals that a brand, company or manufacturer prohibits or restricts from use.
- Guides product formulation within companies; establishes guidelines for manufacturer suppliers of fragrance, raw materials, and finished products; and provides ingredient transparency to consumers.
- Intended for beauty, personal care, and cleaning products.

Cleaning Product Right to Know Act

- Requires ingredient disclosure including fragrance
 - Fragrance ingredients down to 100 pp
 - All hazardous ingredients, regardless of
- Online and on label listing
- Covers retail and institutional products
- In order of predominance, ingredients under 1% any order
- No Trade Secrets for hazardous ingredients



Summary/Suggestions

Great Starting Point

- San Mateo USD has taken important steps – Green Seal Certification

Suggestions Moving Forward

- Ensure supplier compliance with CA disclosure law
- Disclose, or better yet eliminate, fragrances
- Move away from “quats” (ammonium quaternary compounds)
- Ensure all products green certified (Green Seal, EPA Safer Choice)
- Develop a list of ingredients to avoid (RSL)
