- \$5000 grant paid in two \$2500 payments

Requirements

- Attend a 1 day training - Feb 24, 2020
- Conduct a minimum of 4 presentations
 - Students
 - District Administrators
 - Teachers and Appropriate School Staff
 - Wellness Committee and parents
- Provide presentation, agenda, and sign-in sheets

TUPE Tier II

- Applied May 29, 2020 and received \$38,131.55 for three years

Requirements

- Provide Vape Education
- Provide Student Services, Family and Community engagement, PD, and Interagency Partnerships
- Institute the California Healthy Kids Survey
- Collect and review data on a yearly process
