Access to Devices and Connectivity:

- Weekly distribution of devices and hotspots based on request
- More than 500 chromebooks distributed
- More than 50 wireless hotspots distributed

Pupil Participation and Progress:

- All regular LGUSD assessment processes being utilized digitally
- This includes the Developmental Reading Assessment, Common Benchmark Assessments (Math and ELA), and informal English Proficiency Assessments
- LGUSD will also utilize a weekly student engagement log

Distance Learning Professional Development:

- Variety of paid summer PD opportunities for teachers
- Ongoing PD opportunities with regular collaboration time

Staff Roles and Responsibilities:

- Classified staff whose job does not apply to distance learning have been re-assigned to support the sites as needed
- Classroom teachers allowed to work from home or bring their school-aged children to their classroom with them

Supports for Students with Unique Needs:

- All English learners in grades K-5 will receive embedded ELD from their classroom teacher with additional support from an English language tutor as needed
- All English learners in grades 6-8 will receive designated ELD via Zoom

Pupil Learning Loss Strategies:

- Regular assessments to monitor student progress plus support for identified students from math/literacy specialists

Mental Health and Social and Emotional Well-Being:

- Professional development module on Trauma Informed Instruction required of all classroom teachers
- Additional counseling personnel hired
- Additional curriculum materials created and purchased (intended to provide embedded SEL content for all students)
- Weekly student surveys to monitor social and emotional well-being and follow up from counseling staff as needed

Pupil Engagement and Outreach:

- School staff will run a weekly report of any students not attending 60% of the time
- The school site and/or district staff will call families that are not attending regularly asking what support they need
